The Project

The project will reconfigure the interchange at La Jolla Village Drive/ Interstate 805 (I-805) from a full cloverleaf to a partial cloverleaf design and will include bridge widening and ramp realignments.

The Need

These improvements will eliminate the existing weave at the on and off service ramps on I-805 by reconfiguring the interchange from a full cloverleaf to a partial cloverleaf design. Also, by realigning the existing on and off ramps at La Jolla Village Drive, the project would improve safety for pedestrians, and bicyclists and greatly enhance vehicular movements through the interchange area. The project would benefit residents, businesses, and commuters in the mixed use area.

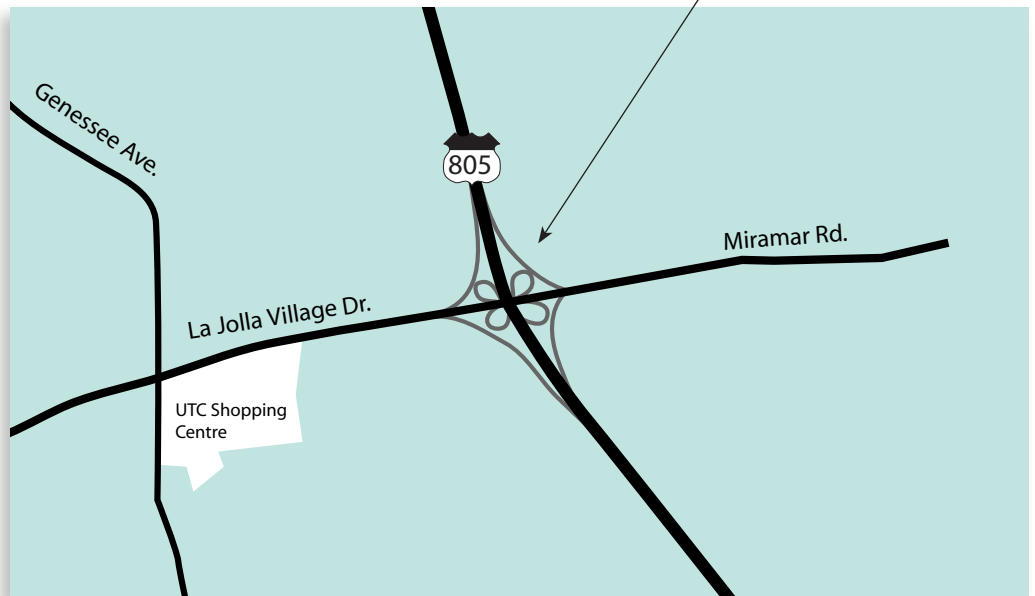
Project Status

An Environmental Impact Statement/ Environmental Impact Report (EIS/EIR) was

approved in May 1998. A reevaluation is pending. The project is 90% designed.

Project Status

Eighty-two percent (82%) of the funds have been allocated. The FY 2007 appropriation request for \$4 million will fully fund this project.
