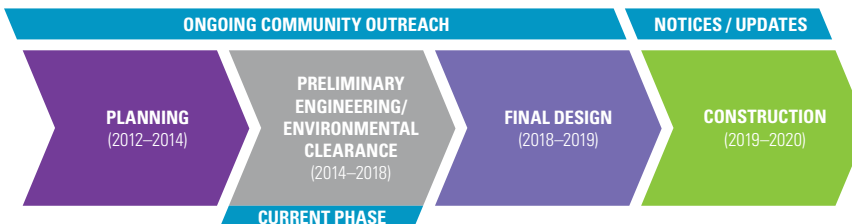

### ABOUT THE PROJECT

The proposed University Bikeway will provide a vital connection for residents to walk and bike between vibrant communities within San Diego's urban core – City Heights, Eastern San Diego, and La Mesa. Proposed features include separated bike lanes, buffered bike lanes, high visibility treatments, and protected intersections designed to make the streets more pleasant for everyone – people who walk, bike, work, and live there. The University Bikeway will run along University Avenue, between Estrella Avenue and 70th Street. The proposed bikeway will also provide an important connection to the Howard – Orange Bikeway to the west and an entire network of high priority regional bikeways just beyond.
