

## Miramar College Transit Station & Mira Mesa Direct Access Ramp Fact Sheet

### \$60 Million Invested in Travel Choices and Transit Services

In Summer 2012, construction began in order to improve travel choices and transit services in the Mira Mesa community. The project will build the new Miramar College Transit Station and Mira Mesa Direct Access Ramp (DAR) connecting Hillery Drive in Mira Mesa to the I-15 Express Lanes.

### **Project Features**

Miramar College Transit Station: As the fifth transit facility in the corridor, this station will feature 12 bus bays, new shelters, and next bus signs which provide updated bus arrival times. It will be located south of the Hillery Drive/Westview Parkway intersection on the northeast edge of San Diego Miramar College. With a direct connection via the new DAR to the I-15 Express Lanes, this facility will help ensure reliable trip times for commuters using local and MTS Premium Express Bus services, as well as future Bus Rapid Transit services.


**Direct Access Ramp**: This is the fifth and final DAR on the I-15 Express Lanes corridor. It includes: one elevated ramp extending at grade from Hillery Drive across southbound I-15, and four onand off-ramps that will connect to the Express Lanes. This DAR will provide direct access to the Express Lanes for carpools, vanpools, buses, motorcycles, and permitted clear air vehicles for free, and to solo drivers with a FasTrak® prepaid account for a fee.
