

## **Overnight Ramp Closures Scheduled on State Route 15**

Crews will close the northbound off-ramp at University Avenue, the northbound on- and off-ramps at Adams Avenue, and the southbound on-ramp at Adams Avenue on State Route 15 (SR 15) Monday, December 7 and Tuesday, December 8, between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. These closures are required to construct bases for new overhead sign structures as part of ongoing work to build San Diego's first freeway-level transit stations along SR 15.

Motorists attempting to access southbound SR 15 from Adams Avenue are encouraged to use El Cajon Boulevard as an alternative to access the freeway. Signs will be posted along the freeway to notify motorists of the closures.

During construction, nearby residents can expect intermittent lights and noise during the evenings and into the early mornings. Crews will work to minimize impacts to nearby businesses, residents, and commuters.

As the safety of motorists and workers is the highest priority, the majority of construction work takes place at night to minimize traffic impacts and allow construction vehicles to move safely in and out of construction zones. We appreciate your patience during construction. Construction schedules are subject to change due to weather conditions.

## ABOUT THE PROJECT

The \$65 million project will build San Diego's first freeway-level transit stations along SR 15 at El Cajon Boulevard and University Avenue. New 2.5-mile transit-only lanes also will be constructed within the existing SR 15 median from just north of Interstate 805 to just south of Interstate 8. The SR 15 Mid-City Centerline Rapid Transit Stations Project is expected to be completed in 2017.

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
