

Overnight Lane and Ramp Closures Scheduled on State Route 15 for March 8

Motorists Will Be Detoured

Crews will close all northbound lanes on State Route 15 (SR 15) from Interstate 805 (I-805) to Interstate 8 (I-8) on Tuesday, March 8, between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. These closures are required to perform concrete paving work as part of the SR 15 Mid-City Centerline Rapid Transit Stations Project.

During this time, the northbound on-ramps at University Avenue, El Cajon Boulevard, and Adams Avenue, the northbound on-ramp from SR 15 to I-8/Camino Del Rio South, and the northbound on-ramp from I-805 to SR 15 will be closed.

Detour signs will be posted directing motorists traveling north on SR 15 to exit at I-805 north, then exit onto State Route 163 north, and then to northbound Interstate 15. Access to Adams Avenue, El Cajon Boulevard, and University Avenue from I-805 will be maintained throughout the closure.

During construction, intermittent lights, noise, and dust can be expected. Construction schedules are subject to change due to weather conditions. We appreciate your patience during construction.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The \$65 million project will build San Diego's first freeway-level Rapid transit stations along SR 15 at El Cajon Boulevard and University Avenue. New 2.5-mile transit-only lanes also will be constructed within the existing SR 15 median from just north of Interstate 805 to just south of Interstate 8. The SR 15 Mid-City Centerline Rapid Transit Stations Project is expected to be completed in 2017.
