## Overnight Ramp Closures Scheduled Next Week on State Route 15

Construction crews will close the southbound on-ramp at El Cajon Boulevard on State Route 15 (SR 15) on Monday, January 25, between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. Additionally, crews will close the northbound off-ramp at El Cajon Boulevard on SR 15 on Tuesday, January 26, during the same times. These closures are required to perform irrigation work as part of the SR 15 Mid-City Centerline *Rapid* Transit Stations Project.

Motorists are encouraged to use University Avenue or Adams Avenue as an alternative. The closures may affect San Diego Metropolitan Transit System (MTS) routes. Please visit [sdmts.com](http://sdmts.com) for detour information.

During construction, nearby residents can expect intermittent lights and noise during the evenings and into the early mornings. Crews will work to minimize impacts to nearby businesses, residents, and commuters. Construction schedules are subject to change due to weather conditions.

As the safety of motorists and workers is the highest priority, the majority of construction work takes place at night to minimize traffic impacts. Night work also allows construction vehicles to move safely in and out of construction zones. We appreciate your patience during construction.

## ABOUT THE PROJECT

The \$65 million project will build San Diego's first freeway-level *Rapid* transit stations along SR 15 at El Cajon Boulevard and University Avenue. New 2.5-mile transit-only lanes also will be constructed within the existing SR 15 median from just north of Interstate 805 to just south of Interstate 8. The SR 15 Mid-City Centerline *Rapid* Transit Stations Project is expected to be completed in 2017.
