Overnight Ramp Closures Scheduled June 28 and 29 on State Route 15

Overnight ramp closures are scheduled on State Route 15 (SR 15) for Tuesday, June 28 and Wednesday, June 29, for paving work as part of the SR 15 Mid-City Centerline *Rapid* Transit Stations Project. The following ramps will be closed each night between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m.

- Southbound on-ramp at Camino Del Rio South
- Southbound and northbound off-ramps at Adams Avenue

During construction, nearby residents can expect intermittent lights and noise during the evenings and into the early mornings. Crews will work to minimize impacts to nearby businesses, residents, and commuters. Construction schedules are subject to change.

As the safety of motorists and workers is the highest priority, the majority of construction work takes place at night to minimize traffic impacts. Night work also allows construction vehicles to move safely in and out of construction zones. We appreciate your patience during construction.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The \$65 million project will build San Diego's first freeway-level transit stations along SR 15 at El Cajon Boulevard and University Avenue. New 2.5-mile transit-only lanes also will be constructed within the existing SR 15 median from just north of Interstate 805 to just south of Interstate 8. The SR 15 Mid-City Centerline *Rapid* Transit Stations Project is expected to be completed in 2017.
