

Overnight Lane and Ramp Closures Scheduled on State Route 15 for Feb. 17 - 19

Lane and ramp closures will be in place along State Route 15 (SR 15) from Wednesday, Feb. 17, to Friday, Feb. 19, to prepare for the installation of overhead sign structures.

- The northbound on-ramps at Adams Avenue and University Avenue and the northbound off-ramp at El Cajon Boulevard will be closed from 7 p.m. on Wednesday to 5 a.m. on Thursday.
- The southbound on-ramp at Adams Avenue and the southbound off-ramp at El Cajon Boulevard will be closed from 7 p.m. on Thursday to 5 a.m. on Friday.

During construction, motorists can also expect periodic lane closures. Additionally, nearby residents can expect intermittent lights and noise during the evenings and into the early mornings. Crews will work to minimize impacts to nearby businesses, residents, and commuters. Construction schedules are subject to change due to weather conditions.

As the safety of motorists and workers is the highest priority, the majority of construction work takes place at night to minimize traffic impacts. Night work also allows construction vehicles to move safely in and out of construction zones. We appreciate your patience during construction.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The \$65 million project will build San Diego's first freeway-level Rapid transit stations along SR 15 at El Cajon Boulevard and University Avenue. New 2.5-mile transit-only lanes also will be constructed within the existing SR 15 median from just north of Interstate 805 to just south of Interstate 8. The SR 15 Mid-City Centerline Rapid Transit Stations Project is expected to be completed in 2017.
