

Overnight Lane Closures Scheduled on State Route 15 between Interstate 805 and Interstate 8

Motorists Will Be Detoured

Crews will close all northbound lanes on State Route 15 (SR 15) from Interstate 805 (I-805) to Interstate 8 (I-8) Wednesday, October 21 and Thursday, October 22, between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. These closures are required to remove overhead sign structures as part of ongoing work to build San Diego's first freeway-level transit stations along SR 15.



In addition to the northbound lane closures, the northbound on- and off-ramps at University Avenue, El Cajon Boulevard, and Adams Avenue, and the off-ramp at Camino Del Rio South will be closed during this time. Detour signs will be posted directing motorists traveling north on SR 15 to exit at I-805 north, then exit onto State Route 163 north, and then to northbound Interstate 15. Access to El Cajon Boulevard and University Avenue from I-805 will be maintained throughout the closure.

During construction, nearby residents can expect intermittent lights and noise during the evenings and into the early mornings. Crews will work to minimize impacts to nearby businesses, residents, and commuters. Construction schedules are subject to change due to weather conditions.

As the safety of motorists and workers is the highest priority, the majority of construction work takes place at night to minimize traffic impacts and allow construction vehicles to move safely in and out of construction zones. We appreciate your patience during construction.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The \$65 million project will build San Diego's first freeway-level transit stations along SR 15 at El Cajon Boulevard and University Avenue. New transit-only lanes also will be constructed within the existing SR 15 median from just north of I-805 to just south of I-8. The project is expected to be completed in 2017.
