## Thursday, March 2

9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

 Central Avenue between El Cajon Boulevard and Meade Avenue closed to through traffic. Access to Central Avenue from El Cajon Boulevard will be permitted for residents only.

## 11:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Northbound SR 15 El Cajon Boulevard on-ramp closed.

## Friday, March 3, at 9 p.m. to Monday, March 6, at 5 a.m.

- Central Avenue between El Cajon Boulevard and Meade Avenue closed to through traffic. Access to Central Avenue from El Cajon Boulevard will be permitted for residents only.
- Southbound SR 15 El Cajon Boulevard off-ramp and northbound SR 15 El Cajon Boulevard on-ramp closed.
- Sidewalk closed on westbound side of El Cajon Boulevard between 37th Street and Marlborough Avenue. Pedestrians will be detoured to eastbound side of El Cajon Boulevard via 37th Street and Marlborough Avenue. At least one lane in each direction will remain open along El Cajon Boulevard.
- Bus stops closed on the northbound and southbound SR 15 El Cajon Boulevard off-ramps and on the westbound side of the El Cajon Boulevard bridge between Central Avenue and 40<sup>th</sup> Street. Please visit sdmts.com for detour information.
