

The list below shows planned closures for the SR 15 Mid-City Centerline Rapid Transit Stations project. Travelers are urged to allow extra time to reach their destination or consider using alternate routes. Construction schedules are subject to change.

Tuesday, March 14, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

- El Cajon Boulevard closed in each direction between 39th Street and Marlborough Avenue. Motorists traveling eastbound on El Cajon Boulevard will be detoured to Orange Avenue via 39th Street. Motorists traveling westbound on El Cajon Boulevard will be detoured to Meade Avenue via Marlborough Avenue.
- Central Avenue closed between El Cajon Boulevard and Meade Avenue. Access to Central Avenue from El Cajon Boulevard will be permitted for residents only.
- Southbound and northbound SR 15 El Cajon Boulevard on- and off-ramps closed.
- Bus stops closed on the northbound and southbound SR 15 El Cajon Boulevard off-ramps and on the eastbound and westbound side of the El Caion Boulevard bridge. Please visit sdmts.com for detour information.

Thursday, March 16, from 11:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Northbound SR 15 University Avenue on-ramp closed.

Friday, March 17, at 9 p.m. to Monday, March 20, at 5 a.m.

- Southbound SR 15 University Avenue off-ramp and northbound SR 15 University Avenue on-ramp closed.
- Sidewalk closed on westbound side of University Avenue between 39th Street and 41st Street. Pedestrians will be detoured to eastbound side of University Avenue via 39th Street and 41st Street. At least one lane in each direction will remain open along University Avenue.
- Bus stops closed on the northbound and southbound SR 15 University Avenue off-ramps and on the westbound side of the University Avenue bridge. Please visit sdmts.com for detour information.
