

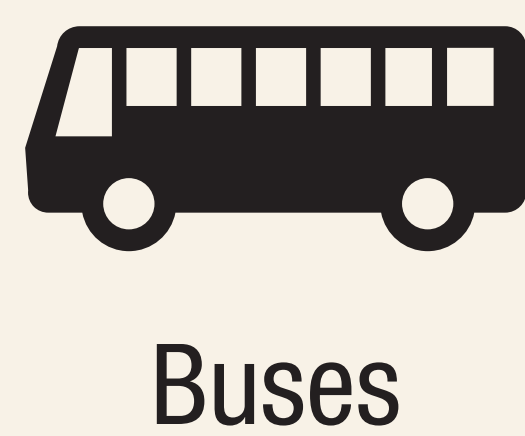
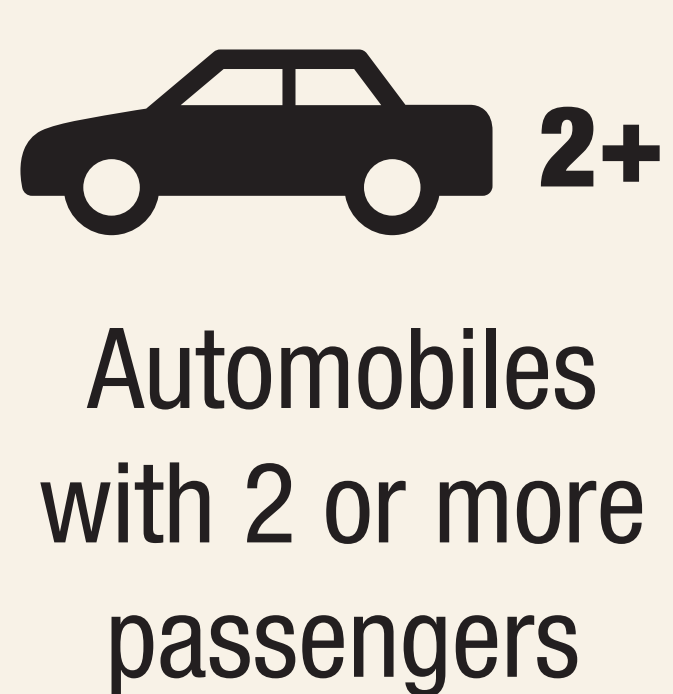
What is a Direct Access Ramp (DAR)?

A DAR allows transit, carpools, vanpools, motorcycles, and solo drivers in permitted clean-air vehicles to enter the carpool/High-Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes without needing to weave through the general purpose lanes from standard on- and off-ramps. This improves safety, reduces congestion, saves time, and increases travel time reliability for both carpool lanes and general freeway travelers.
