


## Poinsettia Station Improvements Project Update

Night Work at Poinsettia Station on Monday, February 10



As part of the Poinsettia Station Improvements Project, construction crews will pour concrete footings for a final segment of intertrack fencing located at the north end of Poinsettia Station during the evening of **Monday, February 10, from 9 p.m. – 5 a.m.,** in the City of Carlsbad. Later in the week, crews will work during regular weekday hours (7 a.m. – 5 p.m.) to install the remaining segment of fencing.

During these activities, nearby residents can **expect construction noise and lights**, which include <u>Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) required vehicle back-up alarms</u>. Residents also can expect to see construction equipment and vehicles moving in and out of the work areas. Crews will work to minimize noise and all other construction-related impacts to surrounding residents.

Please note, construction schedules and activities are subject to change. Thank you for your patience during construction!

## **TRAIN HORN RULES**

Federal regulations require the train engineer to sound the horn when approaching an active construction site, even in a quiet zone. Train horns serve as a warning system to ensure the safety of railroad workers.
