SR 76 East Project Construction Advisory

Preliminary Work Under Way

Pre-construction work along SR 76 between Thoroughbred Lane in Bonsall and Old Highway 395 has started. This work is in preparation for construction of the SR 76 East Segment's second phase, the final portion of SR 76 to be improved.

Current work includes clearing thick brush and trees. Additionally, minor utility relocation work is in progress on the north side of SR 76 near Sweetgrass Lane. This pre-construction work will continue through Saturday, February 15.

Wood generated from this operation will be free to the public and placed just north of the Caltrans Park & Ride lot near Old Highway 395. Power tools and wood processing activities will not be permitted on site.

Construction of the East Segment's second phase will begin this summer to widen and realign SR 76 to a four-lane highway from just east of South Mission Road to the newly improved SR 76/I-15 interchange. This work is the final segment in a series of three improvement projects on the SR 76 corridor between I-5 and I-15 to meet present travel needs and accommodate future growth.
