## Nighttime Lane and Ramp Closures at I-15/SR 76 Interchange: April 14 & 15\*

For your safety, off-ramps from I-15 to SR 76 will be closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. on the nights of Sunday, April 14 and Monday, April 15. Those traveling southbound on I-15 can exit at Mission Road and travel southbound on Old Highway 395 to access SR 76. Those traveling northbound on I-15 can exit at Old Highway 395 and travel northbound on Old Highway 395 to access SR 76.

SR 76 will remain open. Southbound and northbound I-15 will remain open, but will be reduced to one lane in each direction. Please note that you may experience delays. Changeable message signs will be placed in advance of the closure to alert motorists of the work ahead.

Crews are preparing to take down the temporary wood and steel structure that has supported bridge construction for the widening and upgrading of the I-15/SR 76 interchange. This work is part of the final segment in a series of three improvement projects on the SR 76 corridor, located between I-15 and I-5. Stretching 5.2 miles from South Mission Road to I-15, the SR 76 East Segment serves local and regional traffic.

We appreciate your continued patience as we complete these improvements.
