Nighttime Freeway Closure on I-15 at SR 76: April 21 through 25*

For your safety, I-15 will be subject to closure and reduced lanes at the SR 76 interchange each night from Sunday, April 21 through Thursday, April 25, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., as crews finish removing the temporary wood and steel structure that has supported the widening of the SR 76 bridge.

During these closures, motorists travelling on I-15 may be rerouted to exit at the off-ramp to SR 76 and re-enter at the on-ramp.


All on and off-ramps will remain open.

SR 76 will remain open with a flagger directing traffic at the interchange.

Please note that you may experience delays. Changeable message signs will be placed in advance of the closures to alert motorists of the work ahead.

We appreciate your continued patience as we complete these improvements. This work is part of the final segment in a series of three improvement projects on the SR 76 corridor, located between I-15 and I-5. Stretching 5.2 miles from South Mission Road to I-15, the SR 76 East Segment serves local and regional traffic.
