Overnight Partial Lane Closures at the I-15/SR 76 Interchange and Old Highway 395: August 18

Ramps and Lanes at I-15/SR 76 Interchange

Several lanes on both the northbound and southbound I-15, the off-ramps from I-15 to SR 76, and the southbound loop on-ramp from SR 76 to I-15 will be partially closed on Sunday, August 18 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. as crews continue to upgrade the I-15/SR 76 Interchange. During these lane closures, crews will be on site to direct traffic.

Old Highway 395 at SR 76

Additionally during this time, there will be partial lane closures on Old Highway 395 at SR 76. Crews will direct motorists through the intersection.

Throughout the week, crews will intermittently control traffic on SR 76 to stripe and reconfigure lanes on the bridge. Both I-15 and SR 76 will remain open during construction.

We appreciate your continued patience as we complete these improvements. This work is part of the final segment in a series of three improvement projects on the SR 76 corridor, located between I-5 and I-15. Stretching 5.2 miles from South Mission Road to I-15, the SR 76 East Segment serves local and regional traffic.
