

SR 76 East Project Construction Advisory/Noise Alert:

Pile Driving Activity to Occur Between late October & mid-December

Crews will begin construction on the SR 76 East Segment, the last and final portion of the SR 76 Project, in late October. The first phase of this construction will improve the SR 76/I-15 Interchange and will widen the SR 76 bridge over the I-15. This work will begin with driving piles below ground to support the new bridge columns.

The piles will be installed with an impact hammer and driven into the ground to the proper depth. The piles on this project are steel, 30 feet in length, and 2 feet in depth and width.

This work activity can be noisy. To minimize construction noise impacts to neighboring community members and the habitat's animals, all construction equipment will operate with sound-reducing mufflers. The work may occur between 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. from Mondays through Saturdays starting Friday, October 26 through mid-December. Schedule is subject to change due to weather conditions.
