SR 76 Middle Segment Nears Completion — Enjoy the Ride on the New Westbound Lanes

UPDATE: Construction Advisory #7 has been revised to reflect a new date for the opening of the two westbound lanes on SR 76.

Due to weather conditions, the two new westbound lanes on SR 76 between Melrose Drive and Sweetgrass Lane will now permanently open to traffic the morning of **October 18th**. Westbound traffic will move from its current location to these newly completed adjacent lanes. Travelers in the early morning hours that day may encounter intermittent traffic stops, causing minor delays, as crews perform final striping work prior to the opening of the westbound lanes.

The finishing touches are underway for the two eastbound lanes between Sweetgrass Lane and Melrose Drive. The current eastbound lane will remain open to traffic as crews complete final paving and striping operations on the second eastbound lane. The improved eastbound lanes are anticipated to be open to traffic by early November.

The SR 76 project team is also pleased to announce the beginning of construction for the third and final segment of SR 76. Work will begin at the SR 76/I-15 interchange on October 25th.
