SR-76 Middle Project Construction Advisory #4

Two Temporary Closures Along SR-76

This month, the construction along SR-76 is entering a new phase. This will begin with a traffic switch that will move traffic onto the recently completed San Luis Rey River Bridge. Caltrans will perform work that will require two temporary closures:

CLOSURE #1: East Vista Way at SR-76

WHEN: 9:00 p.m. Friday, April 6 to 9:00 p.m. Sunday, April 8* DETOUR #1A (northbound East Vista Way to westbound SR-76)

- Motorists traveling northbound on East Vista Way, take Osborne Street to North Santa Fe Avenue to westbound SR-76.
- Local resident traffic allowed north of Osborne Street.

DETOUR #1B (northbound East Vista Way to eastbound SR-76)

- Motorists traveling northbound on East Vista Way, take Gopher Canyon Road to Little Gopher Canyon Road to Old River Road to eastbound SR-76.
- Local resident traffic allowed north of Gopher Canyon Road to Tushak Ranch Road.

DETOUR #1C (eastbound SR-76 to southbound East Vista Way)

• Motorists traveling eastbound SR-76, take North Santa Fe Avenue to Osborne Street to southbound East Vista Way.

DETOUR #1D (westbound SR-76 to southbound East Vista Way)

• Motorists traveling westbound SR-76, take Old River Road to Little Gopher Canyon Road to Gopher Canyon Road to southbound East Vista Way.

CLOSURE #2: Old River Road at SR-76

WHEN: 9:00 p.m. Sunday, April 8 to 5:00 a.m. Monday, April 9* DETOUR #2 (westbound Old River Road to SR-76)

• Motorists traveling westbound on Old River Road, take Little Gopher Canyon Road, right onto Gopher Canyon Road and right onto East Vista Way to SR-76.

SPECIAL NOTES

- *Schedule is subject to change due to weather conditions.
- Truck restrictions on Osborne Street, Gopher Canyon Road, and Little Gopher Canyon Road will be lifted temporarily during closure and detour dates.
