

Mid-Coast Trolley Project

Construction Activities on Genesee Avenue

Dear Neighbor,

The beginning of Mid-Coast construction is here! While Trolley track installation and station construction are still months away, crews have begun preliminary utility relocation work in your area. Crews are currently working at Genesee Avenue, near the intersection of Eastgate Mall. This work includes street excavations, trenching and installation of water and sewer pipelines. Limited water service interruptions may be necessary to complete this work. Any impacted homes or businesses will be provided with notice well in advance of the service interruption.

Please expect temporary lane closures for the duration of this work. Crews will minimize impacts as much as possible to nearby homes and businesses.

Utility relocation work is anticipated to be completed in spring 2017, however work in your area may be completed before then.

Work Area



Work will begin at the intersection of Genesee Avenue and Eastgate Mall. Work will progress north, along Genesee Avenue.

Schedule

Due to the location and nature of the work, **some night and weekend work is required.** Daytime work hours are Monday through Friday, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Nighttime work hours are Monday through Friday, from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. There may be times when 24-hour work is required. Prior notice to residents and businesses will be provided.
