The trucks will depart for Houston next Friday morning, September 8th.

One container will be sent to World Harvest Outreach in Houston, TX. You may drop off any donations at the MCTC Santa Fe Street project office, located at **5066 Santa Fe Street**. Items they'll accept and need the most include the following:

- Blankets
- Diapers, baby wipes, formula, bottles, portable cribs
- Paper plates & bowls
- Utensils
- Shelf stable foods, canned goods (pop top)
- Snacks, granola bars...
- Peanut butter
- 100% juice
