Full Closures of Interstate 5

Northbound and Southbound Lane Closures for Column Construction

This May, there will be a series of overnight closures of all northbound or all southbound lanes on Interstate 5. Northbound closures of I-5 will be from State Route 52 to La Jolla Village Drive. Southbound closures of I-5 will be from the Interstate 805 merge to Gilman Drive. The following closures will be in place:

Northbound Closures:

- Full closures on Wednesday, May 2 and Thursday, May 3, from 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night.
- Northbound motorists will be detoured via SR 52.

Southbound Closures:

- Full closures on Sunday, May 6, Tuesday, May 8, and Thursday, May 10, from 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night.
- Southbound motorists will be detoured via I-805.

Construction Activities

This work is required to bring equipment into the work area, including drilling and pouring of concrete for the drilled foundation within the center median of Interstate 5. Full freeway closures are required due to the size of the equipment, and the length of the foundation and column, which will be hoisted and set at the same time.

Construction schedules are subject to change.

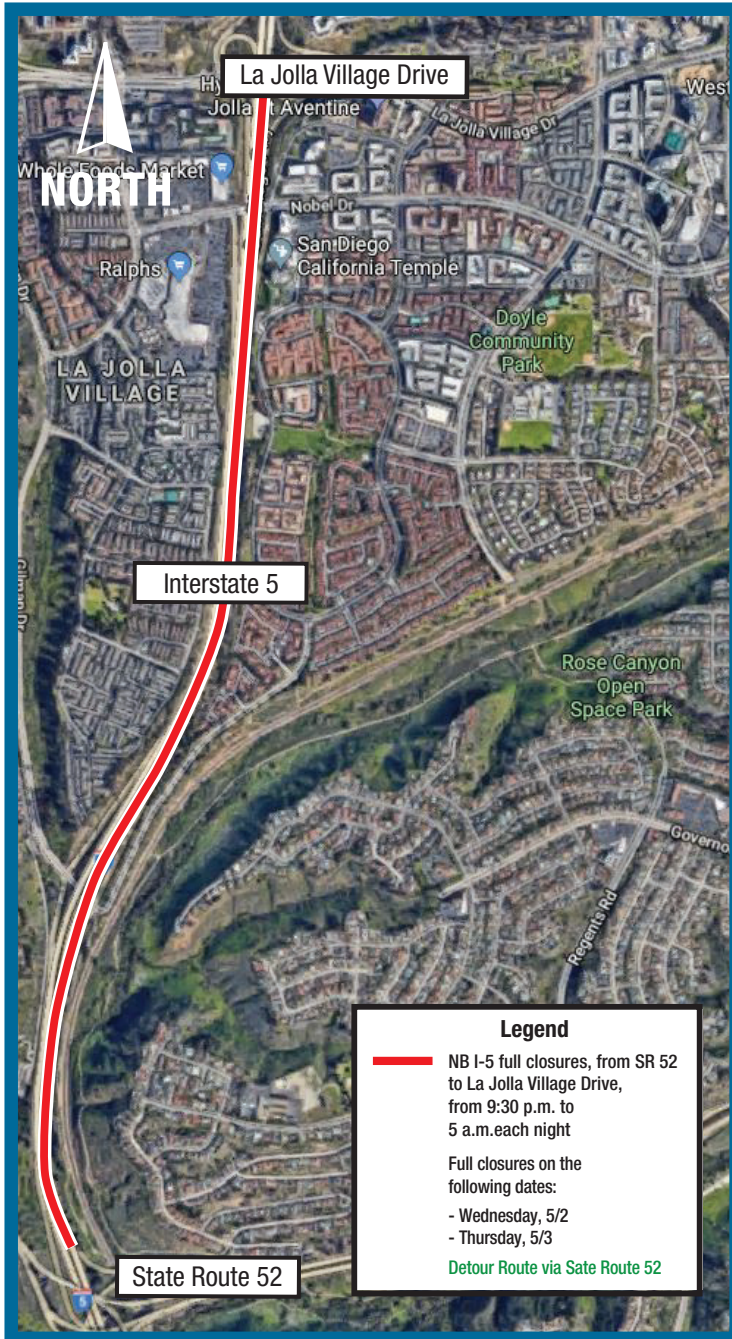

About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend Trolley service from Old Town Transit Center to the University City community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Beach, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and Westfield UTC. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in 2021.
