



## **Restriping & Demolition on I-5**

## **Impacts to Interstate 5 near Nobel Drive and La Jolla Colony Drive**

Beginning January 8, 2018, crews will start the work to construct the viaduct — a bridge structure that will carry the trolley down Interstate 5. This work will be focused within the median of Interstate 5 and will require some lane closures. To prepare for construction, crews will demolish the median and restripe traffic lanes on both northbound and southbound I-5 between the Nobel Drive and La Jolla Colony Drive exits. Barricades will be installed to deliniate the work area in the freeway median. This work will require use of heavy machinery and will generate noise. Crews will minimize

The work will continue through early February 2018.

Traffic controls will remain in place 24 hours a day.

Please heed all traffic signs and use caution when traveling near the work area.

Crews will minimize impacts to neighboring residents and businesses as much as possible.


Construction schedules are subject to change.













## **About the Project**

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend Trolley service from Old Town Transit Center to the University City community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Beach, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and Westfield UTC. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in 2021.
