

CONSTRUCTION OVERVIEW

- Daytime construction hours generally M-F, 7 a.m.– 5 p.m.
- Night time construction hours generally M-F, 7 p.m. – 5 a.m.
- Weekend work, as needed
- Right-of-way acquisition in process
- Traffic Management Plans
- Noise permits for night time work
- Dust mitigation

CONSTRUCTION IN CLAIREMONT AREA

- Late 2016: SB Morena in railroad corridor
- Early 2017: Work/laydown at Tecolote site
- Early 2017: Balboa area LOSSAN bridge, wall, and off ramp
- 2017: Demo/site-work/laydown at Clairemont site
- Early 2018: Station platforms and Tecolote creek LRT bridge
- 2018-2019: Parking, stations, substations, roadways, and traffic signals
- 2019: Balboa area LRT bridge, walls, stairs, etc.







- 7.5 min headways in 2030


Service coordinated with buses at transit centers Barrier free system – roving fare inspectors and security

MOBILITY HUBS

- \$160,000 FTA grant for Mobility Hub implementation strategy
- Centers located at or near transit stations
 - Carshare
 - Bikeshare
 - Bike parking
 - Ride share
 - Bike/pedestrian enhancements
 - Technology to improve transportation (mobile apps, universal payment systems, etc.)
- Strategy will identify implementation plans for Mobility Hubs from Old Town to Westfield UTC Transit Center
