Morena Boulevard, Balboa Avenue, and Santa Fe Street Water and Sewer Utilities Relocation

Water and sewer utility relocation work along Morena Boulevard, Balboa Avenue, and Santa Fe Street will continue in advance of construction on the Mid-Coast Trolley project.

Main construction activities include:

- Street excavations and trenching
- Water and sewer pipeline installation along Santa Fe Street
- Water pipeline installation on Balboa Avenue from I-5 ramp to Morena Boulevard
- Traffic controls will be in place along Morena Boulevard, Balboa Avenue, and Santa Fe Street
- Temporary water service interruptions are necessary to complete this work; residents and businesses will be provided with prior notice before any service interruptions
- Crews will minimize impacts to neighboring homes and businesses as much as possible

Access to nearby businesses will be maintained at all times.

Schedule

Construction activities began in mid-October 2015. The entire Mid-Coast project-related water and sewer utilities relocation work is anticipated to be complete in spring 2017. However work in your area may be completed prior to that date.

Work Hours

Due to the location and nature of the work, **night and weekend work is required**. Daytime work hours are Monday through Friday, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Nighttime work hours are Sunday through Thursday, from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.

There may be times when 24-hour work is required. Prior notice to residents and businesses will be provided.

About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend Trolley service from the Old Town Transit Center to the University City Community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay Park, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and Westfield UTC. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in 2021.
