

Planned Closures and Detours



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail and lagoon improvement projects.

Week of March 26, 2017

HIGHWAY

- Motorists should expect intermittent lane and ramp closures, and reduced lane widths along Interstate 5 (I-5) from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. between Lomas Santa Fe Drive and Birmingham Drive as crews work to install concrete barriers along I-5.
 - Nearby residents can expect intermittent noise and lights, and motorists can expect intermittent overnight lane closures on northbound I-5.
- Motorists should expect delays Sunday, March 26 and Monday, March 27, between 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. and continuing each day Monday March 27 through Friday, March 31, along Manchester Avenue at I-5 as crews work to relocate and identify important underground utilities.
 - Nearby residents can expect intermittent noise and lights.
- Motorists can expect brief, intermittent daytime closures in both directions along I-5 near Manchester Avenue on Sunday, March 26 between 6 a.m. and 10 a.m. as crews remove overhead power lines along I-5.
 - Drivers should anticipate delays on both southbound and northbound I-5 while California
 Highway Patrol monitors traffic flow to allow crews to complete this work. Additionally, nearby
 residents and businesses should not experience any power outages during this work.

RAIL
