
Overnight Detours Planned Tuesday/Wednesday at I-5/Genesee Avenue Interchange

Detour Information for Overnight (Midnight – 4 a.m.) Tuesday – Wednesday

Construction crews will close eastbound and westbound Genesee Avenue from Interstate 5 (I-5) to Scripps Memorial Hospital Drive on Tuesday, June 30, and/or Wednesday, July 1 from midnight until 4 a.m. as crews perform utility work. Scripps Memorial Hospital Drive will remain open to traffic. However, detours will be required for all Genesee Avenue traffic. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained throughout the closure; please watch for flaggers.

Motorists traveling eastbound on Genesee Avenue across the I-5/ Genesee Avenue overpass will be able to access the northbound I-5 on-

ramp. Motorists seeking to travel east of the freeway on Genesee Avenue will detour to southbound I-5, to the eastbound La Jolla Village Drive offramp, and then to Genesee Avenue.

Motorists traveling westbound on Genesee Avenue will be detoured onto southbound Regents Road, then westbound La Jolla Village Drive. Motorists can then access I-5 from La Jolla Village Drive, or continue westbound on La Jolla Village Drive to reach westbound N. Torrey Pines Road/Genesee Avenue.

Additional Closures

In addition, beginning Sunday, June 28 through Thursday, July 2 the I-5/ Genesee Avenue northbound off-ramp will be closed intermittently from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. for construction. During this same period, there will be intermittent lane closures on Genesee Avenue and I-5.

Construction schedules are subject to change.

Progress

Workers will soon begin installing falsework, which are temporary structures used to support the foundation of the new I-5/Genesee Avenue Bridge. Motorists should exercise caution and slow down during construction to help maintain safe travel conditions at the interchange. We appreciate your patience during construction.

About the Project

The \$105 million project will replace the existing six-lane Genesee Avenue overcrossing with a ten-lane structure that will include additional vehicle lanes, sidewalks, and bicycle lanes to better accommodate current and future traffic demands in the San Diego region.
