

» I-5/Genesee Avenue Interchange Project

Planned Closures and Detours

The list below shows planned overnight closures and detours at the Interstate 5 (I-5)/Genesee Avenue Interchange. Monday through Thursday closures may occur intermittently between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists are advised to plan their travel and avoid the area, if possible. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained.

Closures for Monday – Thursday, February 8 – 11

Monday – Tuesday, February 8 - 9

- Northbound on-ramp from Genesee Avenue.
- Intermittent lane closures on eastbound and westbound Genesee Avenue.

Wednesday, February 10

- **SOUTHBOUND I-5 DETOUR (approximately 11 p.m. – 5 a.m.)**

- Exit southbound I-5 at Genesee Avenue.
- Cross intersection.
- Enter southbound I-5 on-ramp.

Motorists using the State Route 56 (SR 56) local bypass attempting to take southbound I-5 will be detoured to southbound I-805, then westbound SR 52. Motorists are advised to use southbound I-5 rather than the SR 56 local bypass to avoid an additional detour. Signs will be placed to alert motorists in advance.

- Intermittent lane closures on eastbound and westbound Genesee Avenue.*

** During regular overnight closures of eastbound Genesee Avenue, two-way traffic will shift to the westbound side of Genesee Avenue.*

Thursday, February 11

- **NORTHBOUND I-5 – DETOUR (approximately 11 p.m. – 5 a.m.)**

- Exit northbound I-5 at Genesee Avenue.
- Cross intersection.
- Enter northbound I-5 on-ramp.

- Intermittent lane closures on eastbound and westbound Genesee Avenue.*

** During regular overnight closures of eastbound Genesee Avenue, two-way traffic will shift to the westbound side of Genesee Avenue.*

Please note construction schedules are subject to change. Closures are weather permitting.

Project limits include Science Center Drive to the main entrance at Scripps Hospital on Genesee Avenue, and Sorrento Valley Road to Voigt Drive on I-5.
