Crews to Conduct Nighttime Work to Remove Debris at Los Peñasquitos Lagoon

Recent heavy rains, combined with high tides, caused flooding at one of the Los Peñasquitos Lagoon Bridges Replacement Project sites resulting in some construction materials being deposited in the lagoon. As such, SANDAG worked with the Los Peñasquitos Lagoon Conservancy and environmental permitting agencies on a plan to remove the construction materials without disturbing the lagoon environment.

Crews are scheduled to begin the removal of the debris overnight on **Wednesday, April 26, from 12 a.m. to 4 a.m.** Intermittent overnight work is expected the rest of this week. A certified biologist will be on site at all times during the removal of the construction materials to ensure all necessary steps are taken to protect the lagoon environment. Nearby residents and businesses can expect to see some lights and a crane near Carmel Valley Road. Additionally, this coming weekend is a scheduled Absolute Work Window, where crews will be working around the clock on the northernmost rail bridge. SANDAG will work to minimize noise and other impacts to nearby residents and businesses during this work. Thank you for your patience.

About the Project

SANDAG is working in collaboration with North County Transit District (NCTD) to replace the four aging, wooden trestle railway bridges in the Los Peñasquitos Lagoon with modern concrete bridges. The lagoon bridges were built between the 1910s and 1930s. The new single-track bridges will help meet current and future demand for intercity, commuter, and freight rail services. Construction began in late 2015 and is expected to be complete mid-2017.
