Overnight Closures of I-5 at Genesee Avenue This Week

Closures

Interstate 5 (I-5) will be closed at Genesee Avenue in one direction intermittently overnight on Wednesday and Thursday, February 17-18, between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. while workers remove temporary construction structures on the bridge.

Motorists will be detoured around the freeway closures. Northbound I-5 will be closed intermittently overnight on Wednesday, and southbound I-5 will be closed intermittently overnight on Thursday.

There will be additional ramp and lanes closures on Genesee Avneue these nights and throughout the week. Please view our online closure list. Motorists are advised to plan their travel and avoid the area, if possible. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained.

Detours

Motorists will be detoured at the interchange to the Genesee Avenue off-ramp and reenter using the on-ramp across the intersection. Please view the graphic for details.

Motorists traveling south on I-5 who wish to use the State Route 56 local bypass on Thursday night will be detoured to southbound Interstate 805 then westbound State Route 52. Signs will be placed to alert motorists in advance.

The \$105 million project will replace the existing six-lane Genesee Avenue overcrossing with a ten-lane structure that will include additional vehicle lanes, new bicycle lanes and sidewalks, and better accommodate current and future traffic demands in the San Diego region.
