

Residents Can Expect Construction Activities Saturday, March 4

On Saturday, March 4, from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m., crews will be constructing temporary access roads along San Elijo Avenue in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, just north of the lagoon, and near Harbaugh Trails in Solana Beach as part of the San Elijo Lagoon Double Track Project.

Nearby residents can expect intermittent daytime noise, traffic control, and delays. Crews will work to minimize noise and other impacts to nearby residents and businesses. Your patience during construction is appreciated.

TRAIN HORN RULES

Federal regulations (49 CFR Part 222) require train conductors to sound the horn when approaching an active construction site, even in a quiet zone. Train horns serve as a warning system to ensure the safety of railroad workers. About the San Elijo Lagoon Double Track Project

The San Elijo Lagoon Double Track Project is a \$72.8 million project that will add 1.5 miles of new double track from Cardiff-by-the-Sea to the southern border of the San Elijo Lagoon, replace the wooden trestle bridge over the San Elijo Lagoon with a modern concrete bridge, construct a new pedestrian undercrossing at the south end of the lagoon, and improve the signal and grade crossing at Chesterfield Drive. This project is part of Build NCC and will take approximately two years to complete.
