CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Crews Preparing for Construction Next Two Weeks

Over the next two weeks, residents and businesses can expect to see construction activities in the area as part of work to double track the coastal rail line and replace the bridge over the San Elijo Lagoon. The work will include:

- Relocating signage, including plaques, throughout the project area in close coordination with the Cardiff 101 Association. The signage will be re-installed after the project is complete.
- Installing temporary Environmentally Sensitive Area (ESA) fencing to delineate vegetation and lagoon boundaries.
- Installing silt fencing, or a temporary barrier, around the bridge to protect the water quality of the lagoon from sediment.
- Delivering temporary dirt fill to build access roads. A southern access road will be built off Coast Highway 101 near the Gateway Parcel. Trucks will first enter at the N. Rios Avenue Trailhead at the southern end of the lagoon to bring in the dirt for the Coast Highway 101 access road. A second temporary access road will be constructed off San Elijo Avenue, near Manchester Avenue.
- Installing lagoon trail closure signs near lagoon trail entry points to notify hikers of closed trails. Please pay close attention to trail closures for your safety.
- Clearing and grubbing the project area, including removing all landscaping to prepare the area for construction.*

Work will take place Monday through Friday, between the hours of 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. with night work as needed. Residents can expect to see heavy equipment in the project area, noise, and traffic impacts as crews conduct their work. **Please note that although some trees and landscaping will need to be removed to make room for the new construction, they will be replaced with new landscaping at the end of the construction phase.*



About the San Elijo Lagoon Double Track Project

The San Elijo Lagoon Double Track Project is a \$75.7 million project that will add 1.5 miles of new double track from Cardiff-by-the-Sea to the southern border of the San Elijo Lagoon, replace the wooden trestle bridge over the San Elijo Lagoon with a modern concrete bridge, construct a new pedestrian undercrossing at the south end of the lagoon, and improve the signal and grade crossing at Chesterfield Drive. This project is part of Build NCC and will take approximately two years to complete.
