

Overnight Work to Install Concrete Barriers and Restripe I-5

Motorists can expect delays on I-5 near Solana Beach and Encinitas

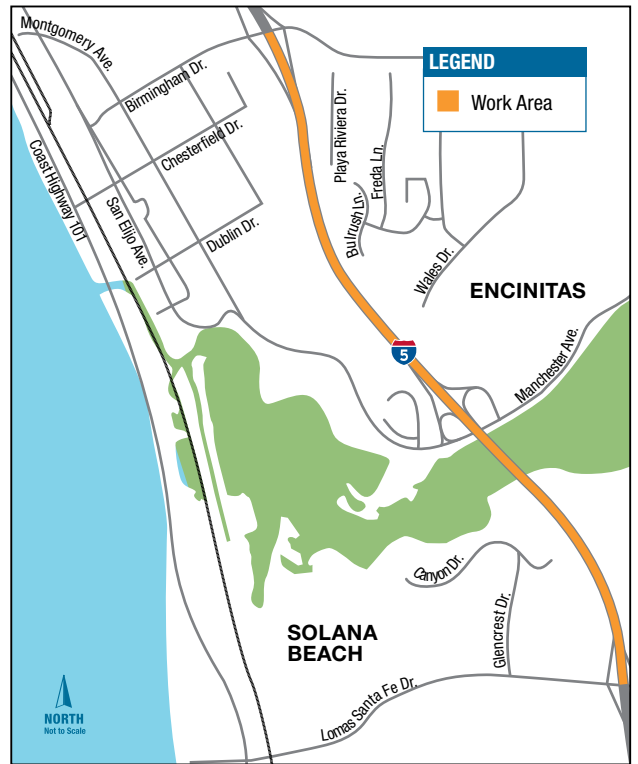
Beginning Sunday night, March 12, work will begin to restripe Interstate 5 (I-5) and install concrete barriers between Lomas Santa Fe Drive in Solana Beach and Birmingham Drive in Encinitas as part of the Build NCC project to extend the carpool lanes on the freeway. Motorists can expect traffic delays, intermittent overnight lane and ramp closures, and reduced shoulder and lane widths during construction. Lane widths will be restored once work has been completed in 2021.

The work to restripe the freeway and add concrete barriers will be conducted Sunday through Thursday nights between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. and will continue for approximately three weeks. Nearby residents can expect intermittent noise and lights during construction.

Motorists are encouraged to allow more time to reach their destination. Be Work Zone Alert, Move Over a lane when safe to do so and slow when highway workers are present with amber lights flashing.

During construction, SANDAG has expanded its Freeway Service Patrol program, which is a free service that improves safety for stranded motorists and reduces traffic congestion during peak hours. If you find yourself in need of assistance, call, "511," and ask for, "Roadside Assistance."

About Build NCC

Build NCC is the first phase of construction in the cities of Solana Beach, Encinitas, and Carlsbad as part of the North Coast Corridor Program. Build NCC includes extending the existing carpool lane on I-5 in each direction from Lomas Santa Fe Drive to State Route 78, double tracking the rail line at the San Elijo Lagoon, replacing the highway and rail bridges at the San Elijo and Batiquitos lagoons, restoring the San Elijo Lagoon, and constructing nearly 10 miles of new bike and pedestrian trails. Construction on Build NCC began in early 2017 and will be complete by 2021.
