

SR-76 Middle Project Construction Advisory #3

Two Temporary Closures Along State Route 76 (SR-76)

The construction along SR-76 is entering a new phase soon which will require placing SR-76 traffic onto recently completed sections of the roadway between North River Road and Olive Hill Road/Camino Del Rey. To make the traffic switch, please be advised of the following temporary closures.

Closure #1: North River Road at SR-76

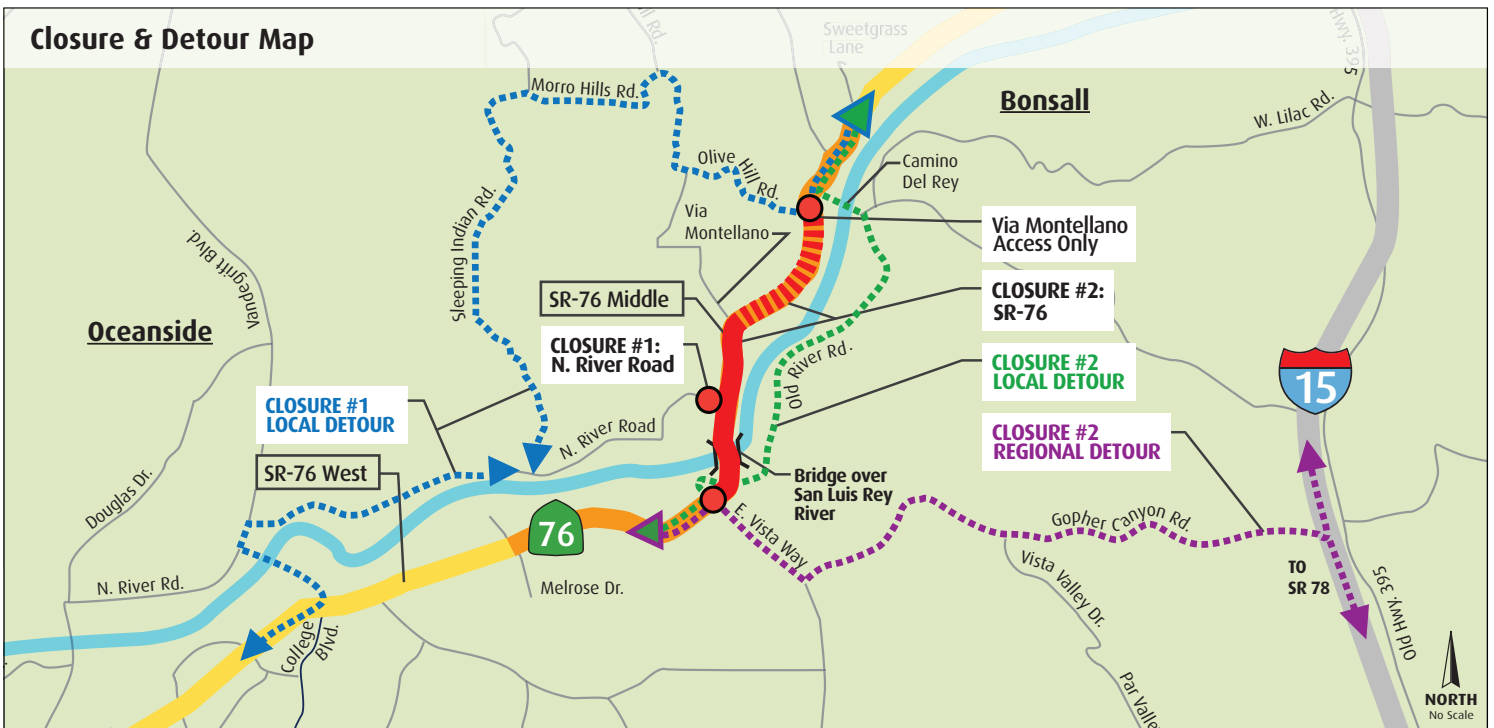
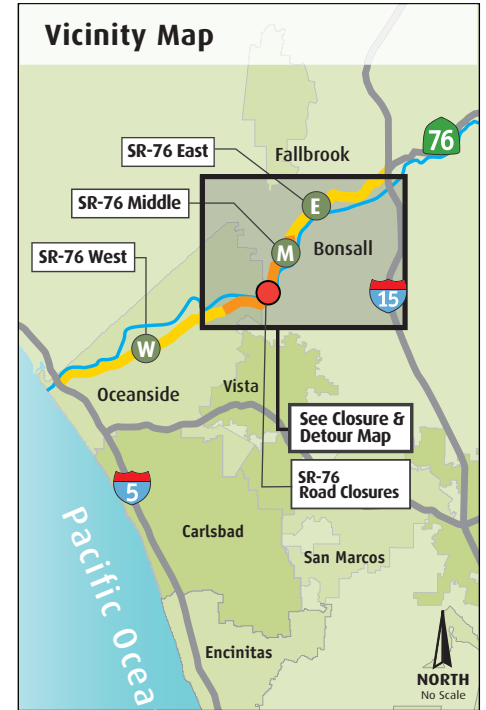
- **WHEN:** 8:00 p.m. Friday, August 12th to 5:00 a.m. Monday, August 15th
- **LOCAL DETOUR:** Use Olive Hill Road/Morro Hills Road/Sleeping Indian Road or use College Boulevard/Vandegrift Boulevard.

Closure #2: SR-76 between E. Vista Way and Olive Hill Road

- **WHEN:** 9:00 p.m. Sunday, August 14th to 5:00 a.m. Monday, August 15th
- **LOCAL DETOUR:** Use Old River Road
- **REGIONAL DETOUR:** Use E. Vista Way/Gopher Canyon Road for I-15 or SR-76 West

Special Note for Via Montellano Residents

In May 2010, a red card was distributed to Via Montellano residents. Show this card to the CHP Officer at Olive Hill Road to access your home between the hours of 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. on the nights of the full highway closure. Please keep this card for future full highway closures. To the Bonsall community:

The SR-76 Middle Segment Project is making progress and is about to enter a new phase soon. This advisory is sent to update you on the following information:

- ▶ Temporary Closure on North River Road at SR-76
- ▶ Temporary Closure on SR-76 between E. Vista Way and Olive Hill Road
- ▶ Special Note for Via Montellano Residents

Traffic detour signs will be posted along these routes. We appreciate your continued patience as we complete these roadway improvements.

Construction for this segment began in early 2010 and is targeted for completion in late 2012. Costing approximately \$171.4 million, this two-lane highway will be widened and realigned to four lanes between Melrose Drive and South Mission Road. Once constructed, the project will reduce traffic congestion and enhance safety for SR-76 travelers.
