



The list below shows planned construction activities for the South Bay Rapid project. Travelers are encouraged to allow extra time to reach their destination or consider using alternate routes. Please note, construction schedules are subject to change.

Construction activities for the week of June 5

Heritage Road to Olympic Parkway – City of Chula Vista

- Periodic lane closures and reduced on-street parking in both directions along East Palomar Street between Santa Flora and Heritage roads for construction of the transit guideway
- Periodic noise and dust possible along East Palomar Street between Santa Andrea Street and Heritage Road as crews continue construction of the Heritage Rapid Station
- Sidewalk closure along the south side of East Palomar Street between Santa Delphina Avenue and Santa Flora Road as crews continue installation of a stormwater detention basin
- Crosswalk closure along East Palomar Street at the Santa Alicia Avenue and Santa Andrea Street intersections for construction of new crosswalk ramps
- Motorists should expect delays at the intersection of East Palomar Street and Santa Andrea Street on Tuesday, June 6, between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. for utility improvements

Magdalena Avenue to State Route 125 (SR 125) - City of Chula Vista

Periodic construction noise and dust possible near Impressionist Drive as crews continue installation of falsework and construct retaining walls for installation of privacy walls

Town Center Drive to Birch Road – City of Chula Vista

- Periodic noise, dust, and lane closures near the Otay Ranch Town Center as crews install utilities and excavate dirt for this portion of the dedicated transit guideway
- Closure of the northwest corner of Mall Ring Road at the Otay Ranch Town Center from Tuesday, May 30, until Friday, June 23, for utility and roadway improvements
