- Connects Uptown to Old Town, Mission Valley, Downtown, North Park, and Balboa Park
- Introduces inviting and convenient bikeways that link key community destinations, including schools, parks, transit, and commercial centers
- Features streets with reduced traffic stress levels, safer crossings for people walking, enhanced streetscape, and increased transportation choices
- Incorporates pedestrian enhancements such as high-visibility crosswalks, curb extensions, dual curb ramps, and other amenities that help create safer pedestrian crossings
- Constructs parking changes in Phase 1 that are both physically necessary for the project and increase capacity, such as angled and head-in parking
