PURPOSE OF TRAFFIC AND SAFETY IMPACT ASSESSMENT

The Traffic and Safety Impact Assessment analyzes the vehicular traffic impacts and bike and pedestrian safety impacts of the project. Preparation of this assessment is required before the SANDAG Board of Directors can make a determination that the project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).



KEY FINDINGS



UPTOWN BIKEWAYS PROJECT SEGMENTS 1-4




59 Roadway Segments and 92 Intersections
