## **Beyer Boulevard Trolley Station Parking**

January 2 - June 2015

Due to construction, please plan for alternate parking Jan. 2 through June 2015. Parking will be reduced to approximately 25 spaces, including ADA-designated parking, while construction is ongoing.

Additional parking is available at Ocean View Church located at 2460 Palm Avenue. Please follow signs to the 'MTS Trolley Temporary Parking' in the back lot. Parking is also available at 8th, 24th, and E Street Stations. To plan your travel to these stations by bus, visit sdmts.com/TripPlanner.asp or call 511 to speak to a transit information specialist.

Renovation work at the Beyer Boulevard Trolley Station will continue through June 2015. The station will remain open during construction, however passengers will be detoured to a temporary platform to access the Trolley.

## **The Trolley Renewal Project**

The Trolley Renewal Project is a joint project of the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) and the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System (MTS). Once complete, new low-floor Trolleys will operate throughout the system. All stations will be equipped with next-arrival signs, new shelters, and seating. The end result will be easier access, quicker trips, a more comfortable ride, and an enhanced transit experience. This work is part of a \$660 million project to renew the entire MTS Trolley network. Funding for the project was provided by *TransNet*, the regional half-cent sales tax for transportation administered by SANDAG; California Proposition 1A and 1B; and the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.
