



NIGHTTIME NOISE ALERT

Construction at Blue Line Trolley Tracks

Construction work on the Blue Line Trolley tracks in your area will be ongoing **Monday, July 6, through Friday, July 10. Nightly work hours are 7 p.m. through 4 a.m.**

This work includes removing and replacing thousands of wooden railroad ties and smoothing out the finished track section. This operation requires the use of lighting and heavy machinery. Please expect 2-3 hours of work in your immediate area while this moving operation travels through the work zone. In order to operate in a safe and efficient manner, this work must be completed during the Trolley system's non-operation hours, as crews work directly on the Trolley tracks.

As crews complete work in each area, they will progress through the corridor to complete the entire rail tie replacement operation, including both eastbound and westbound tracks. Crews will return to your area in **mid-July** for clean-up related to the rail tie work. While this is a separate operation, it will require the use of lighting and heavy machinery.

Due to the nature and complexity of the work, this schedule is tentative and subject to change. Crews will minimize any noise or dust impacts as much as possible. We appreciate your patience as we complete this final phase of the Blue Line track to improve your Trolley system.
