University Avenue

- ~2.8 mi (Estrella Avenue to 69th Street)
- Protected/buffered bikeways, protected intersections, bus islands
- Approval of protected intersections largely based on community support
- \$8.6M ATP Grant + \$5.8M TIRCP Grant – *Thanks for your support!*
- Anticipate construction in 2022

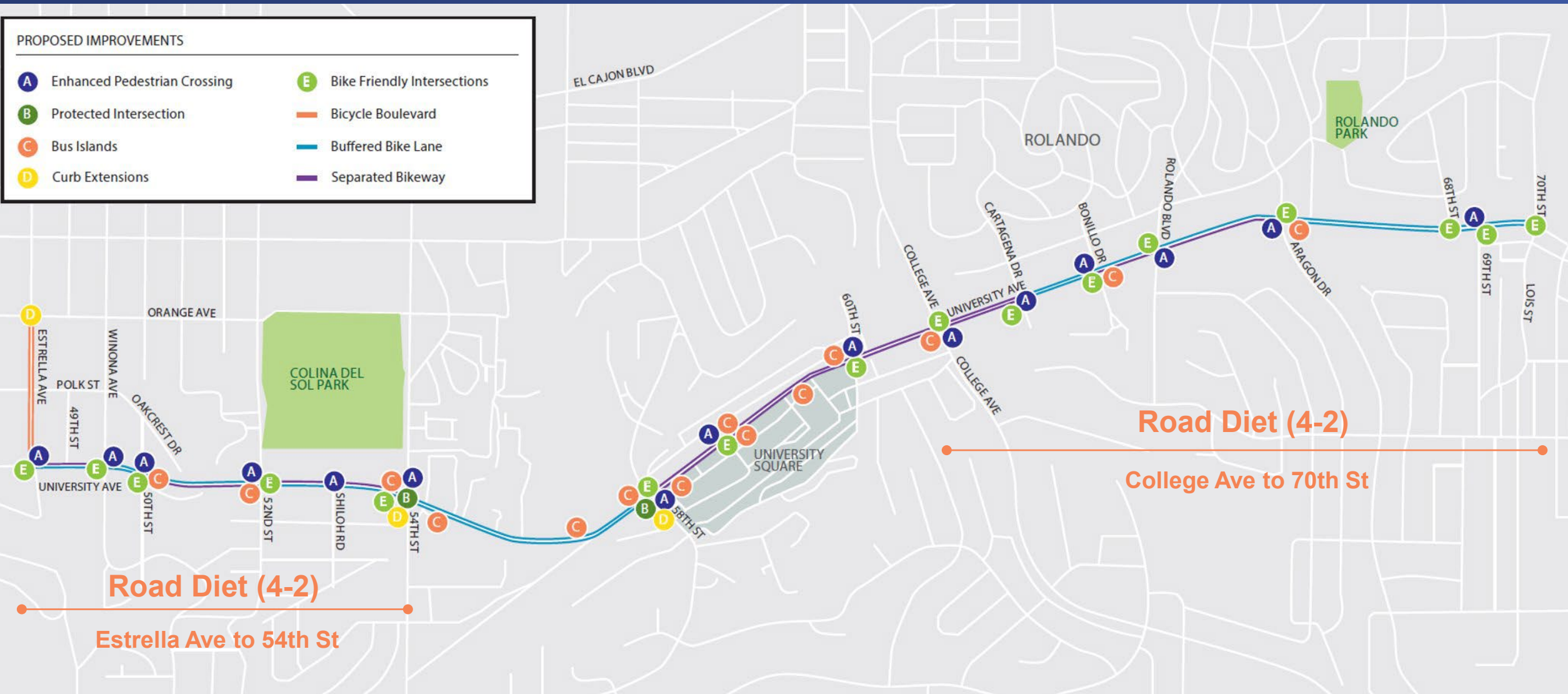

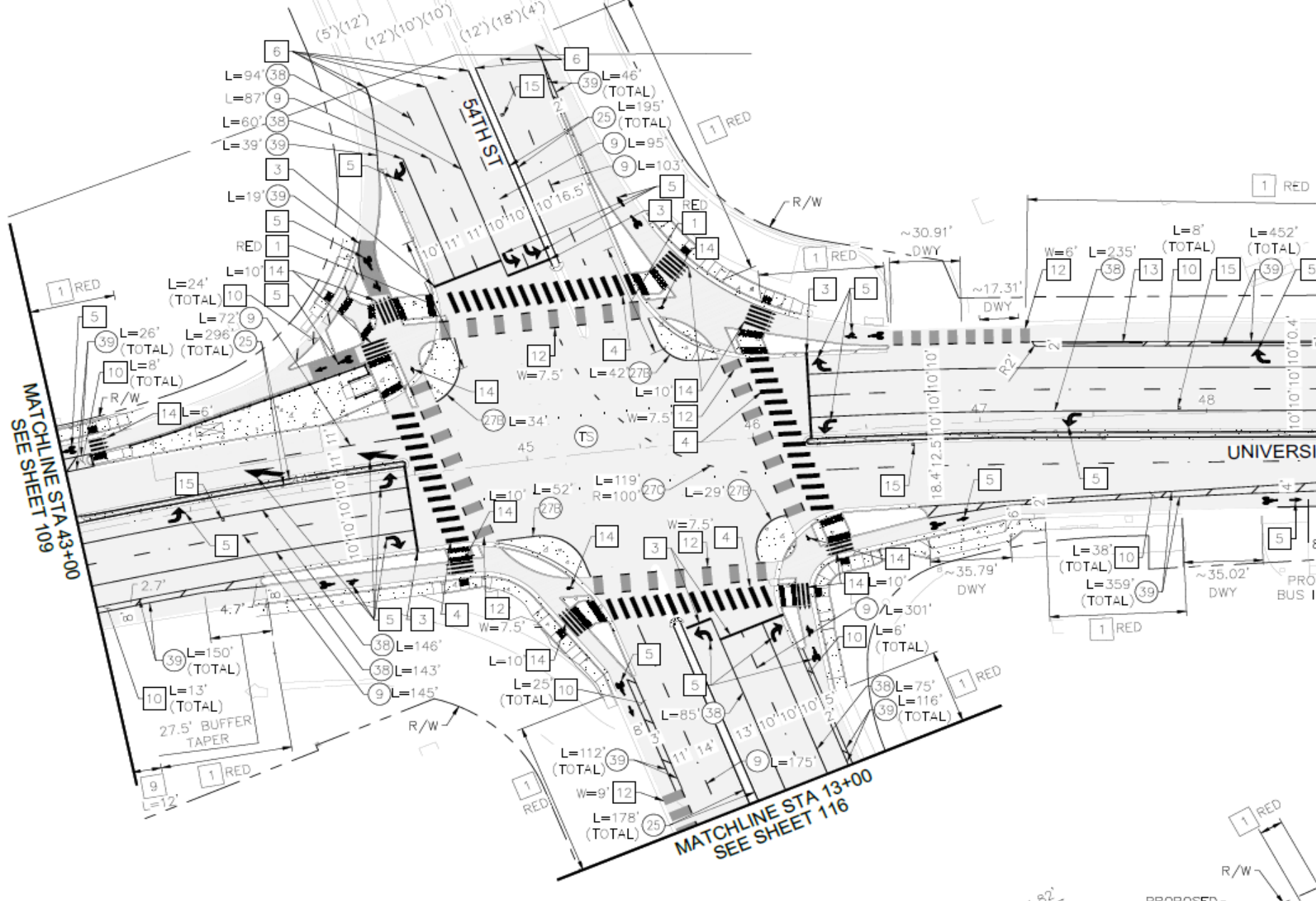

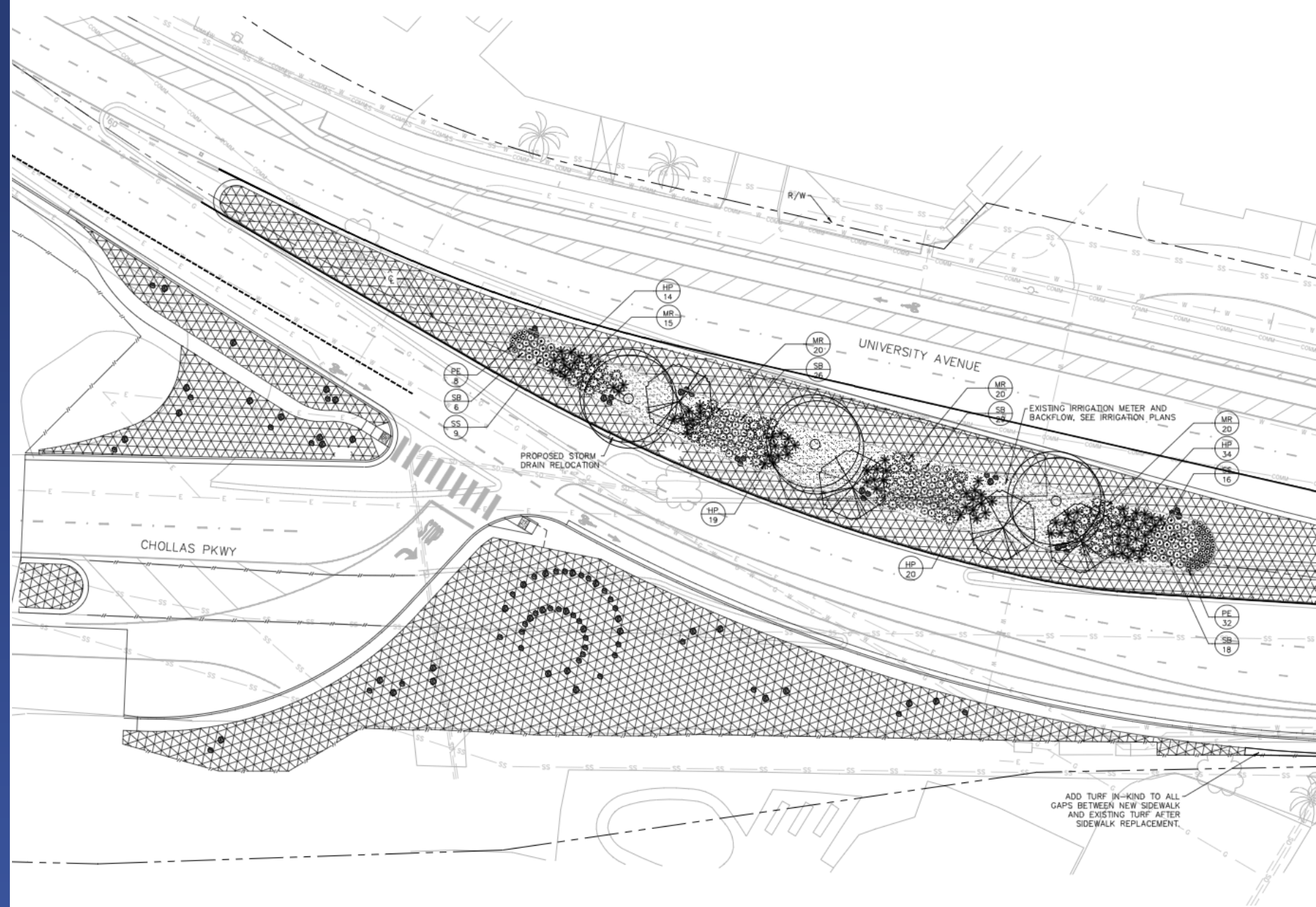

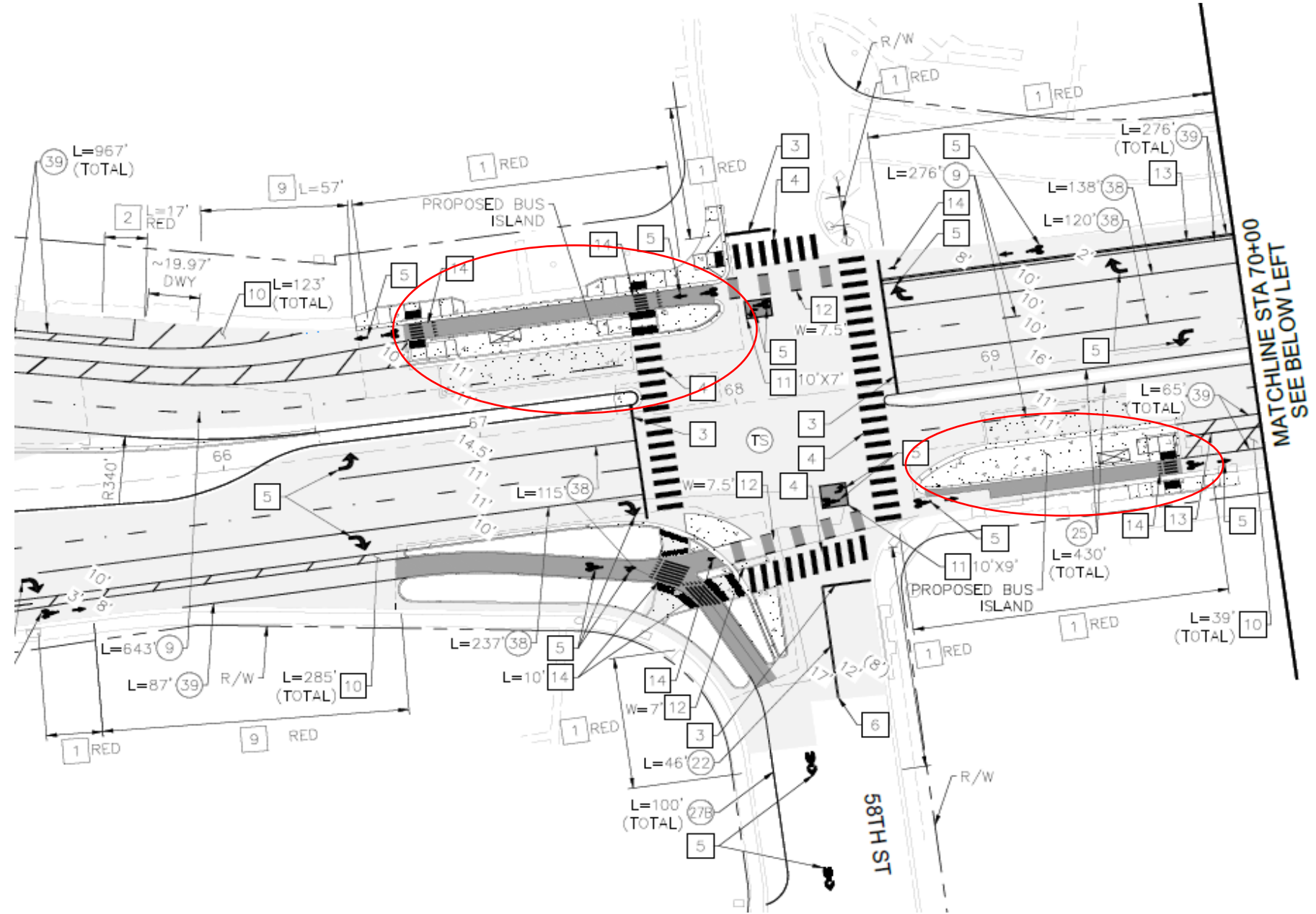

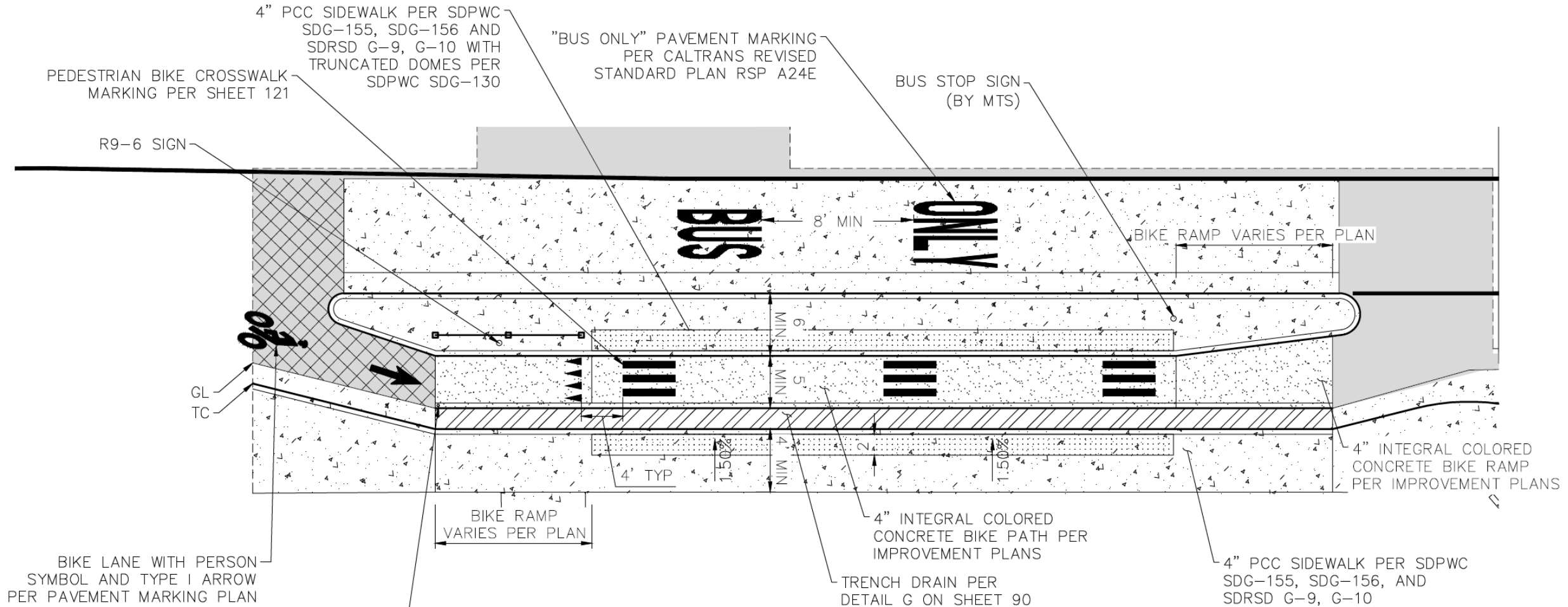

Typical Design A

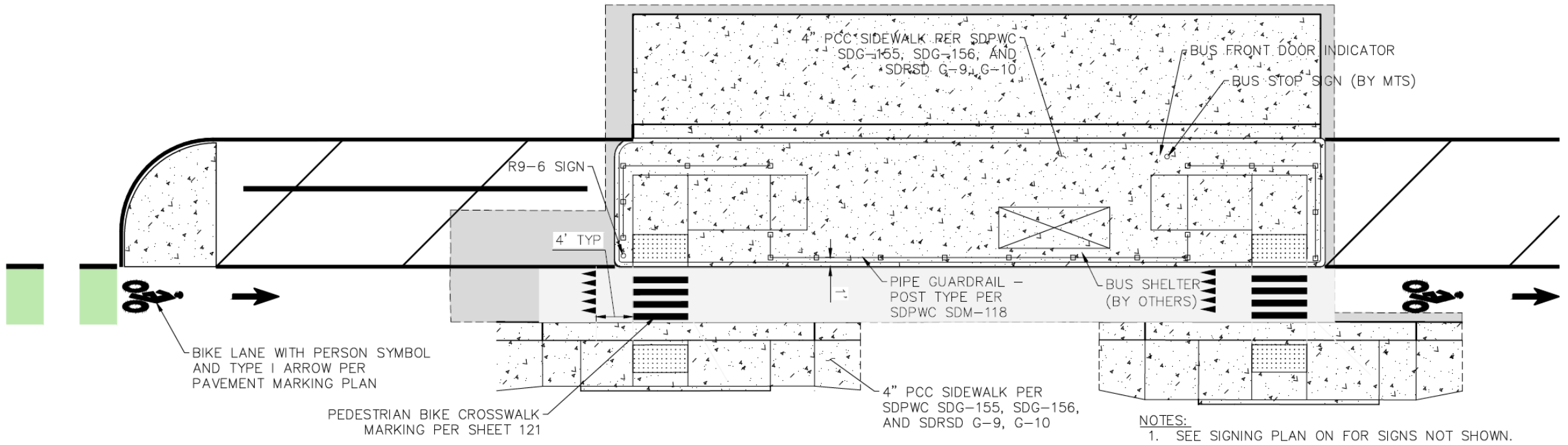

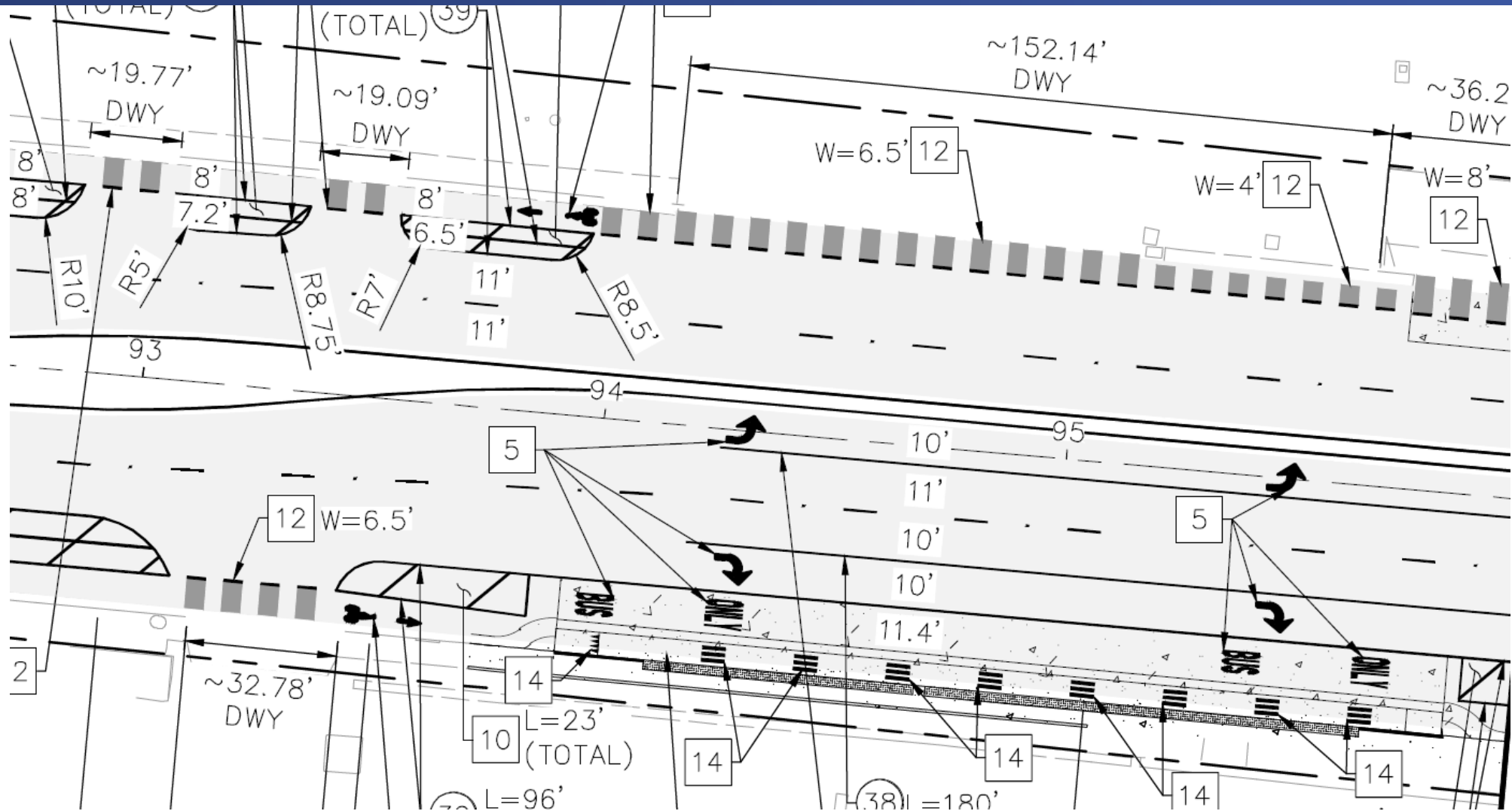

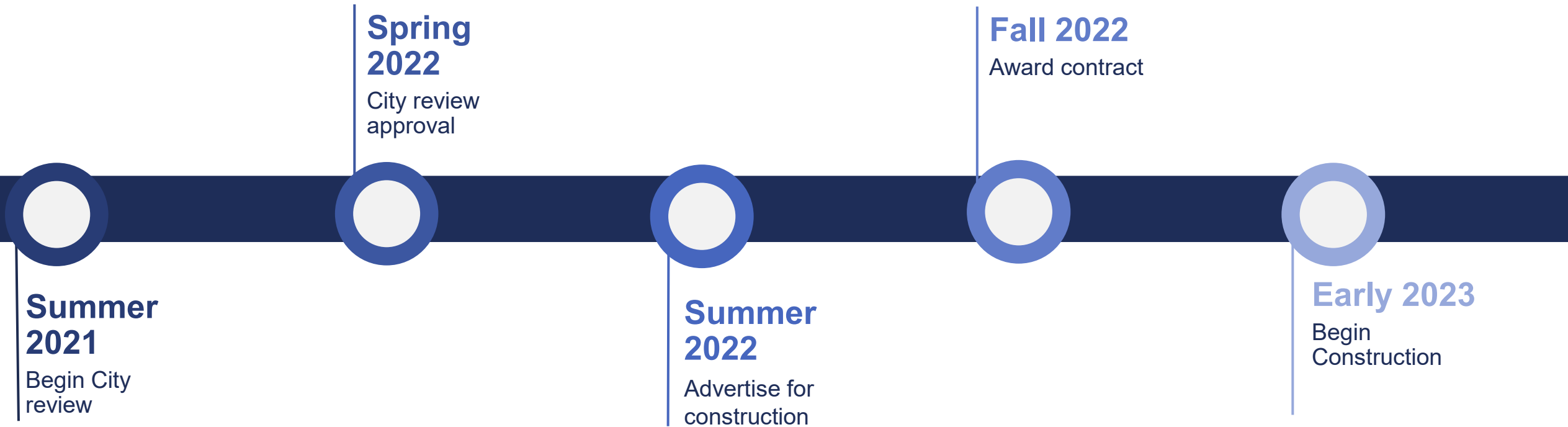
Submittal to City Review – Summer 2021
