



- In March 2023, SANDAG mailed 13,600 homeowners, residents, and businesses along the project corridor providing notice for upcoming start of construction.

WORK TO BEGIN ON THE BORDER TO BAYSHORE BIKEWAY PROJECT

Construction of the Border to Bayshore Bikeway project will begin this month and is anticipated to last approximately 2 years. In preparation for the start of construction, SANDAG will host a virtual Construction Information Session via Zoom on Thursday, April 6 at 6 p.m. Spanish interpretation will be available. ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Border to Bayshore Bikeway is a 6.5-mile bikeway that will connect the world's busiest land border crossing at the San Ysidro Port of Entry to the Bayshore Bikeway in Imperial Beach. The project aims to provide safe biking connections within and between the communities of San Ysidro, San Diego, and Imperial Beach. Once complete, the project will provide a vital connection for residents and visitors to travel to and from the Mexican border. helping fulfill the vision laid out in the San Diego Bike Plan Early Action Program (EAP).

Related Project: Construction of the Beyer Boulevard Slope Improvements Project in San Ysidro is expected to begin in July 2023.

Phase I Outreach Efforts

- In July 2023, more than 8,000 residents and businesses received a postcard in English and in Spanish notifying them about the start of construction on Beyer Boulevard and the potential impacts on people moving through the area.
- In July 2023, 212 flyers were hand-delivered to residents and businesses in the community. Phase 1 Flyers were available in English and Spanish.

 conduct outreach in close conjunction with
 stakeholders of the Border to Bayshore
 Bikeway project.

WORK TO BEGIN ON THE BORDER TO BAYSHORE BIKEWAY

In July, construction of the Border to Bayshore Bikeway project will begin along Beyer Boulevard in San Ysidro! The first phase of construction will take place between Dairy Mart Road and Del Sur Boulevard and is anticipated to be completed in fall 2023.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT

- Parking will be temporarily unavailable along Beyer Boulevard between Dairy Mart Road and Del Sur Boulevard during construction. "No Parking" signage will be in place.
- · Beyer Boulevard will be reduced to one lane in each direction beginning July 14.
- The intersection of Beyer and Del Sur Boulevards will temporarily turn into a three-way stop.
- Physical barriers and signage will be placed throughout the corridor to direct traffic.

Please stay out of the construction zone at all times and be Work Zone Alert.

Recent Construction Activity

Phase I – on Beyer Boulevard between Dairy Mart Rd. To Del Sur Blvd.

 In July, construction of the Border to Bayshore Bikeway project began along Beyer Boulevard in San Ysidro! The first phase of construction will take place between Dairy Mart Road and Del Sur Boulevard and is anticipated to be completed in fall 2023.

Anticipated Schedule:

- The next construction phase will occur between 30th Street and Iris Avenue.
- We anticipate that this segment will be open to public in 2025.

Eblast Notices

- Eblast Notices are sent in English and Spanish on a continual as-needed basis.
- These construction notices allow SANDAG staff and construction teams to remain in close contact with stakeholders in the Border to Bayshore project at every step of the way, providing up-to-date access to project updates, including impending travel impacts.


What to expect:

Construction Activity on Beyer Boulevard

between Dairy Mart Road and Del Sur Boulevard

- Demolition of existing pavement for future construction of new median island and new paving on Beyer Boulevard.
- Poured concrete for new sidewalk on Beyer Boulevard.
- Completed grading of median island on Beyer Boulevard.
