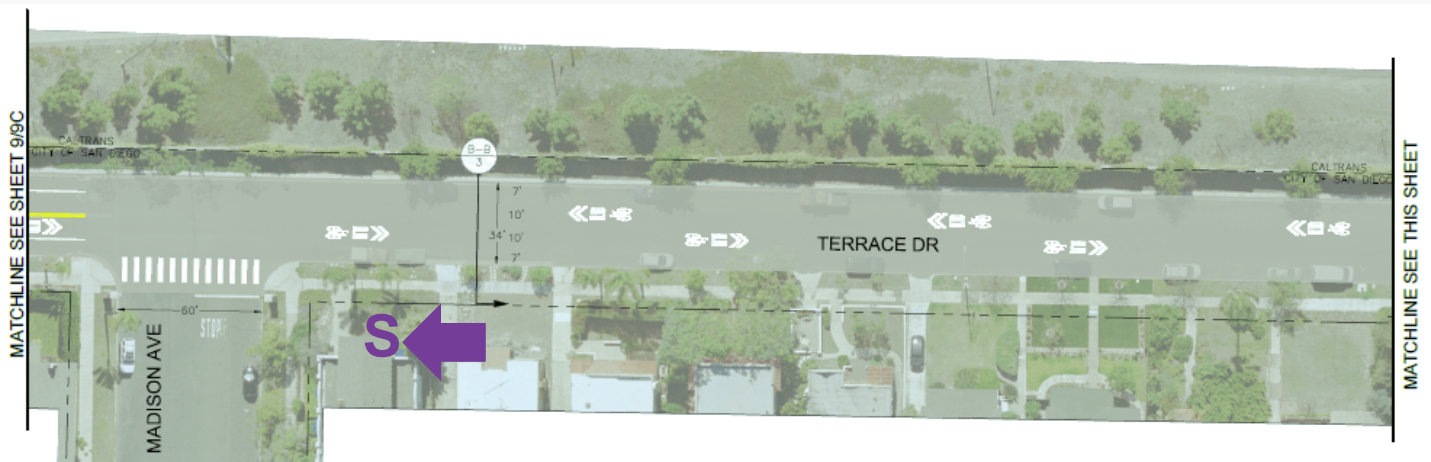
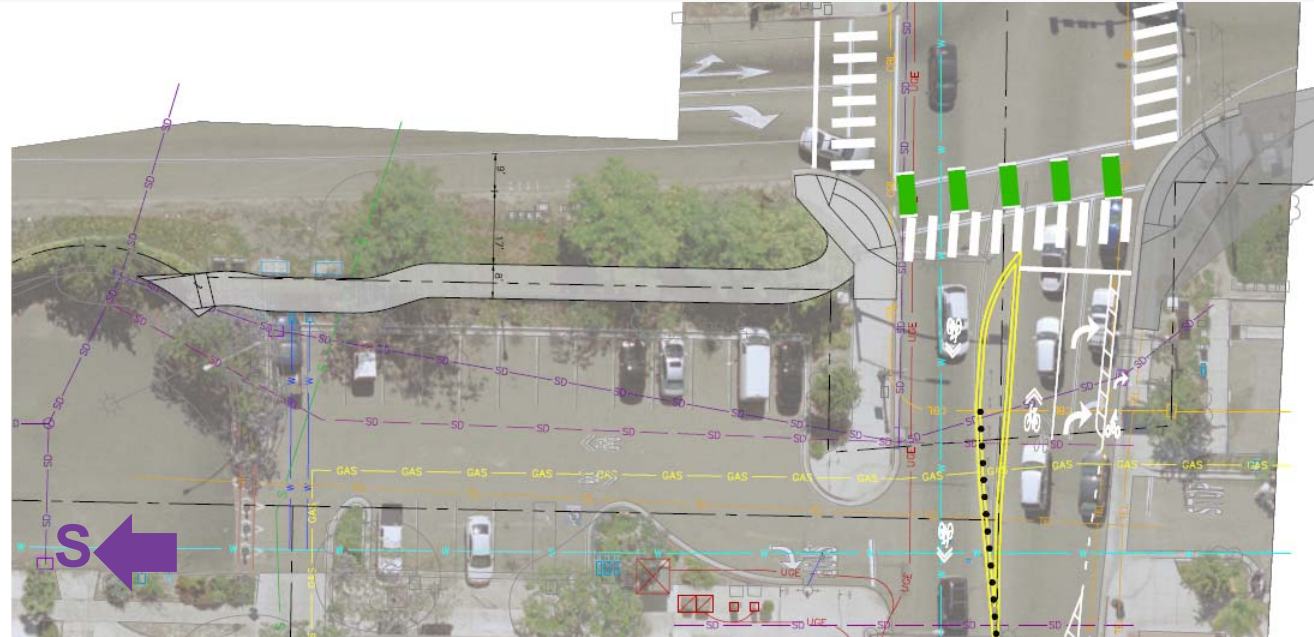
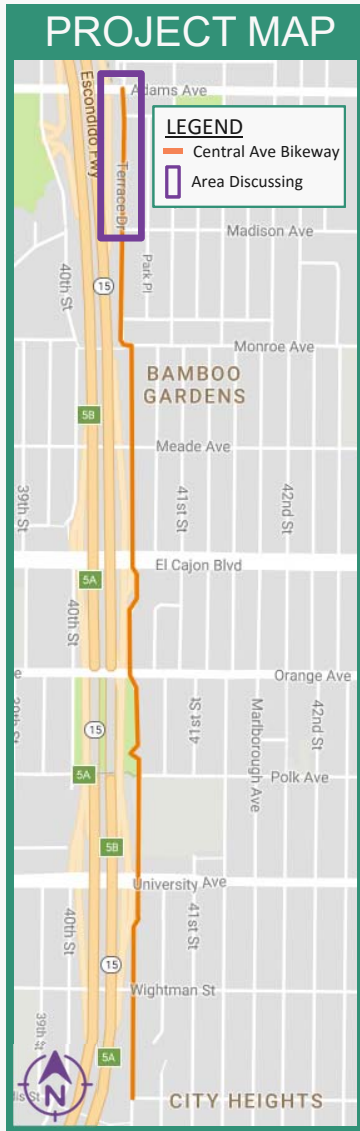
A NORTH-SOUTH CONNECTION

- A combination of bikeway types on Terrace and Central avenues from Adams Avenue to Landis Street
 - A little over 1 mile
- Intersects with North Park | Mid-City Bikeways
 - Monroe and Meade Bikeways
 - Howard – Orange Bikeway
 - Landis Bikeway
- Connects the east-west network





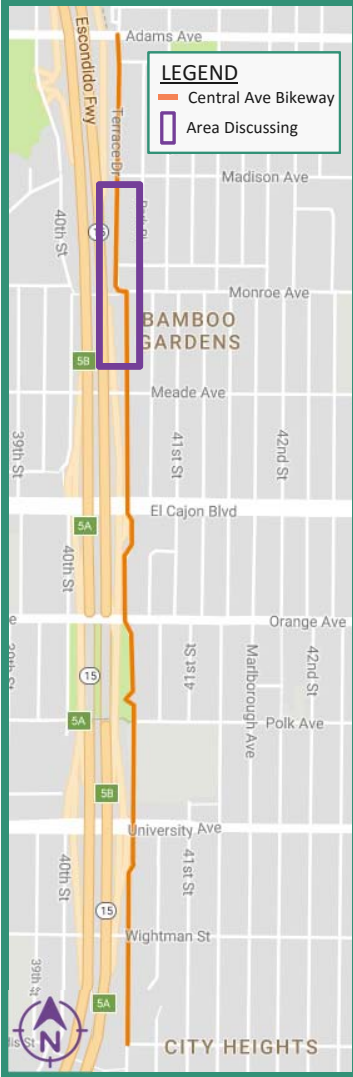

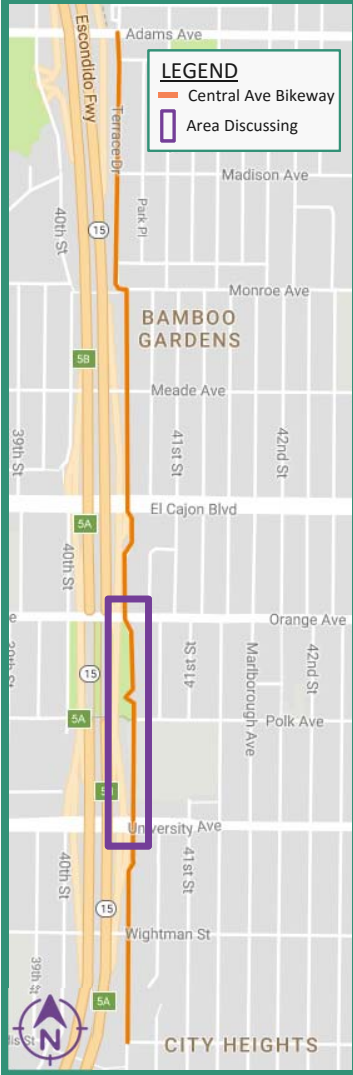
ALTERNATIVE DESIGN WITH CUL DE SAC

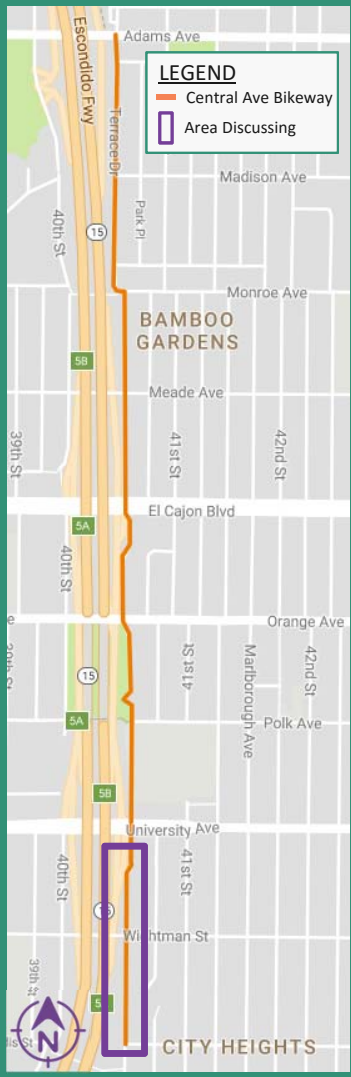
