CENTRAL AVENUE BIKEWAY

A NORTH-SOUTH CONNECTION

- A combination of bikeway types on Terrace Dr. and Central Ave. from Adams Ave. to Landis St.
 - A little over 1 mile
- Intersects with North Park | Mid-City Bikeways
 - Monroe and Meade Bikeways
 - Howard – Orange Bikeway
 - Landis Bikeway
- Connects the east-west network

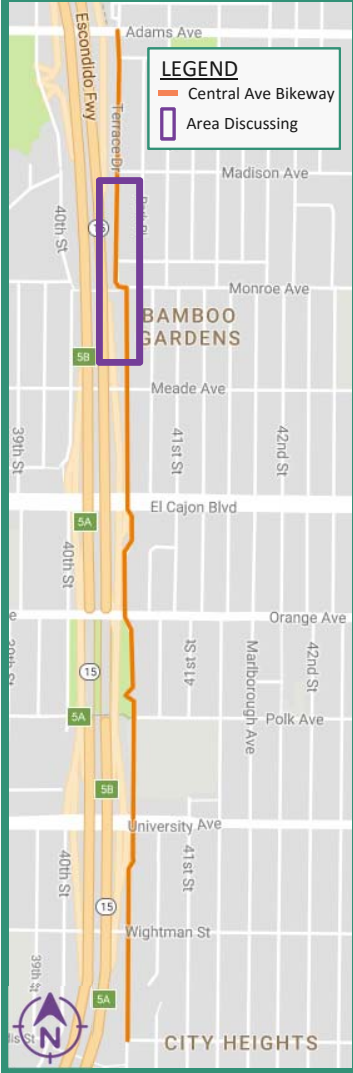

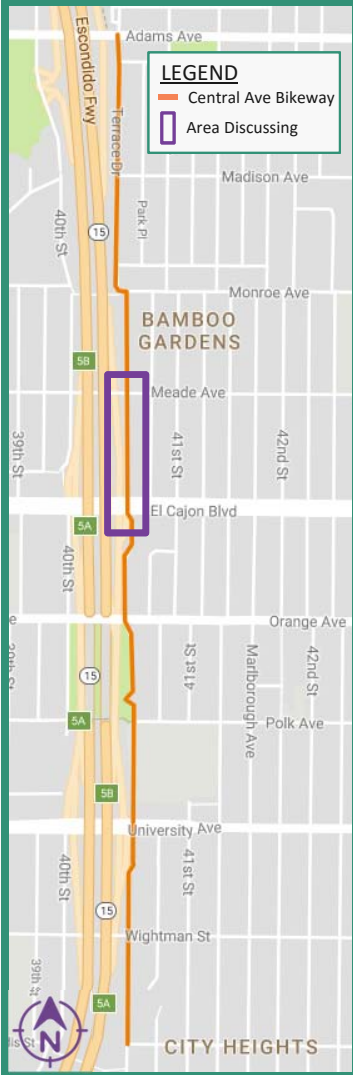

30' RADIUS ALTERNATIVE

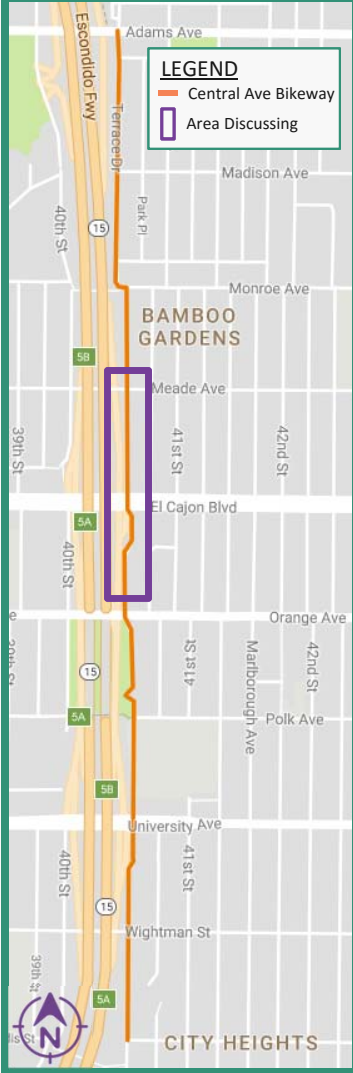


15' RADIUS ALTERNATIVE

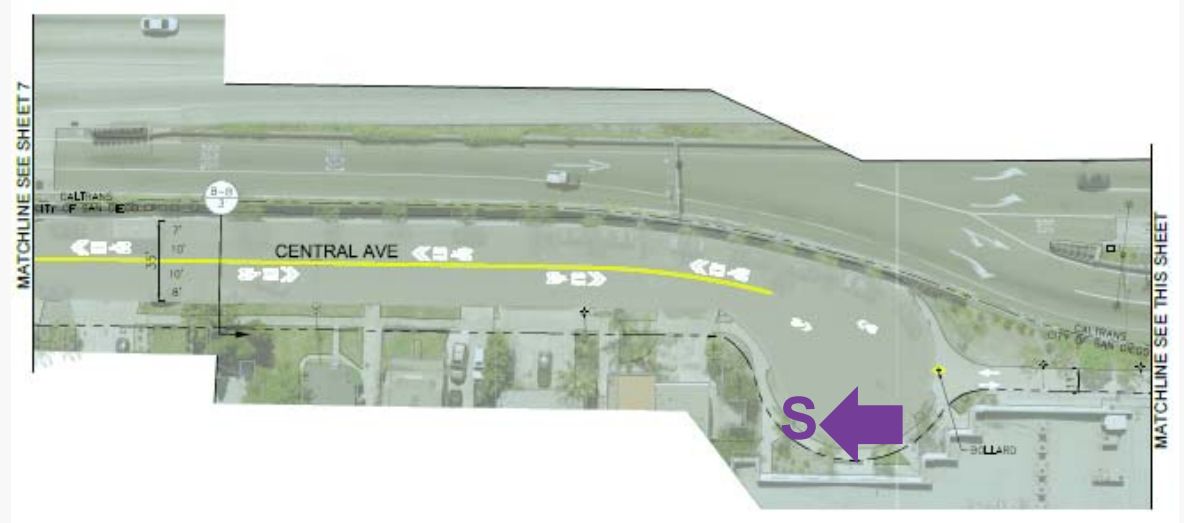
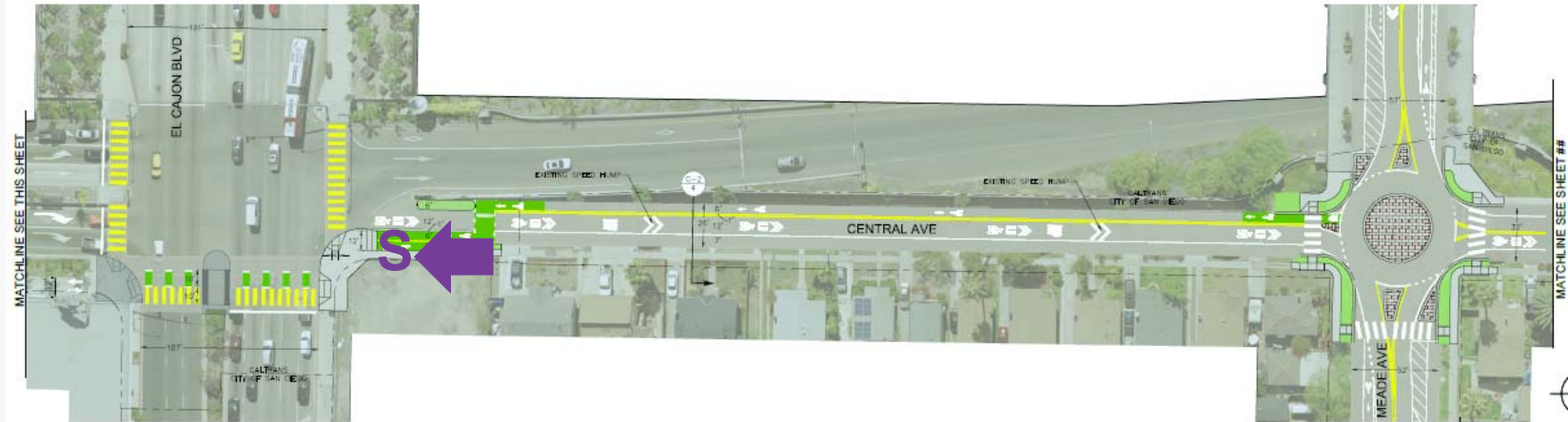

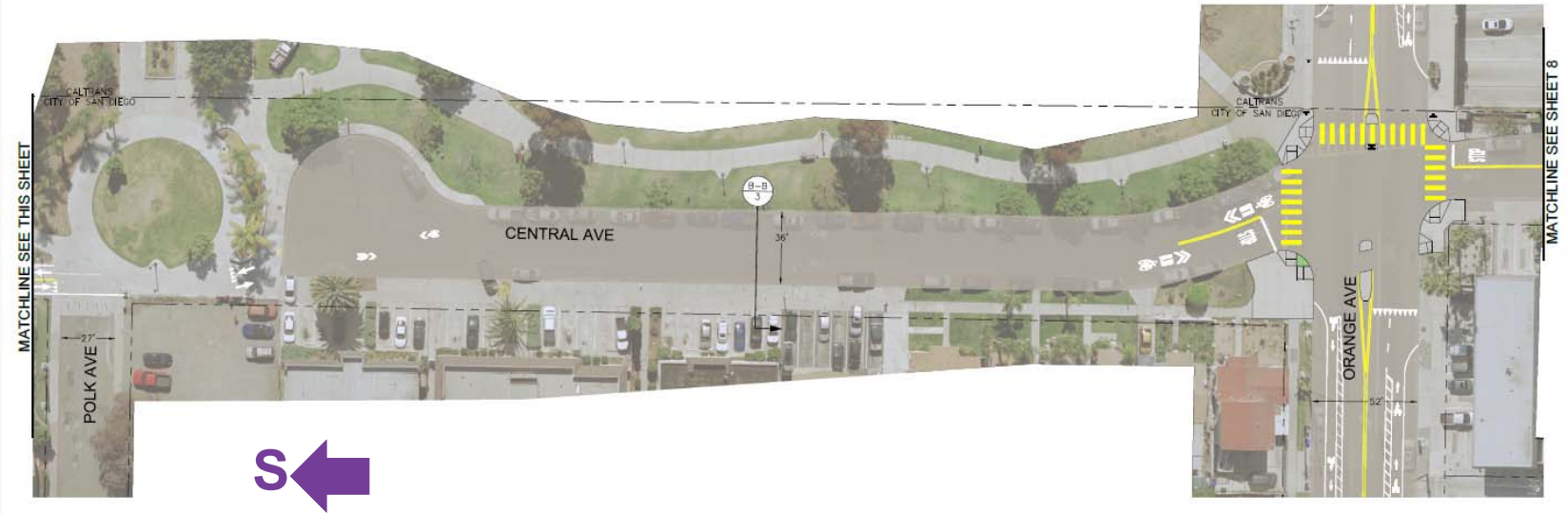


ALTERNATIVE DESIGN WITHOUT STREET CLOSURE





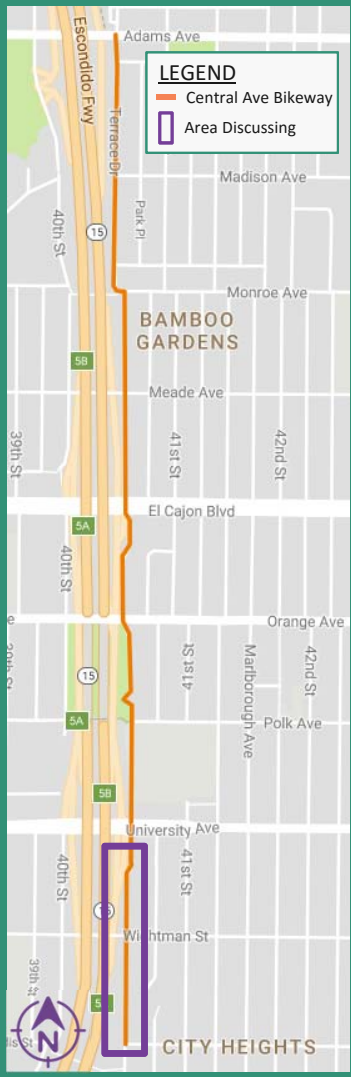

CENTRAL AVENUE BIKEWAY
The Central Avenue Bikeway will provide a safe connection to many destinations within the San Diego communities of City Heights, Kensington, and to adjacent neighborhoods. Starting at the north end, the 1.2 mile bikeway will begin in Kensington where the SR 15 Connector Bikeway ends at Adams Avenue and continue south, parallel to SR 15, along Terrace Drive and Central Avenue to Landis Street in City Heights.

PROVIDE YOUR FEEDBACK
The February 26th open house and public hearing marks an important step for the Central Avenue Bikeway project. SANDAG, as the lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), will hold a public hearing to hear comments on the proposed project. During the open house portion of the meeting, attendees will have the opportunity to talk with project team members and provide feedback. Spanish and Vietnamese translation and interpretation will be provided. The SANDAG Transportation Committee is anticipated to consider whether the proposed project is exempt from CEQA at its April 20, 2019 meeting. Comments collected at the public hearing and open house and written responses to those comments will be provided to the Transportation Committee for its consideration before their April 20, 2019 meeting.
