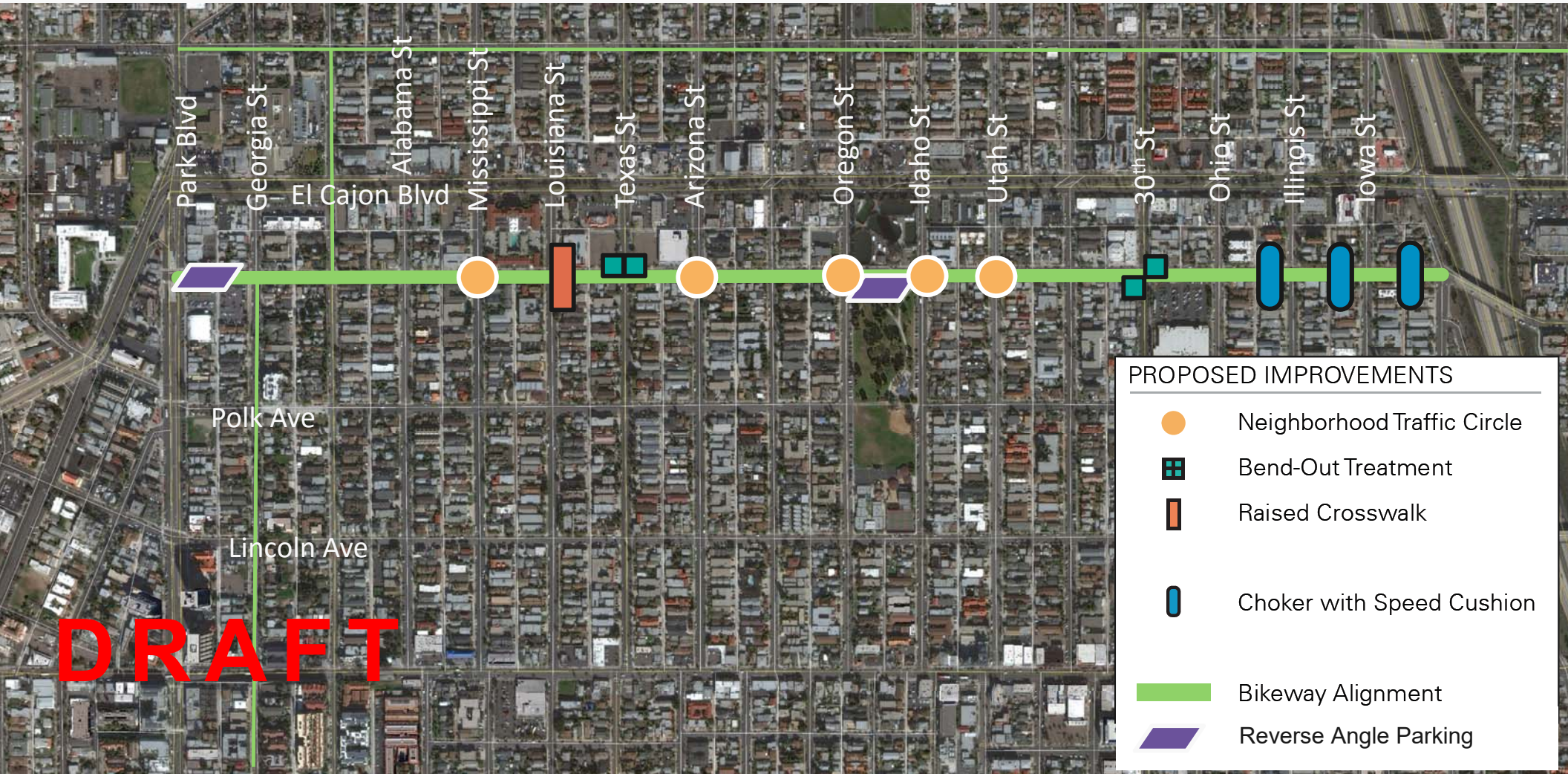

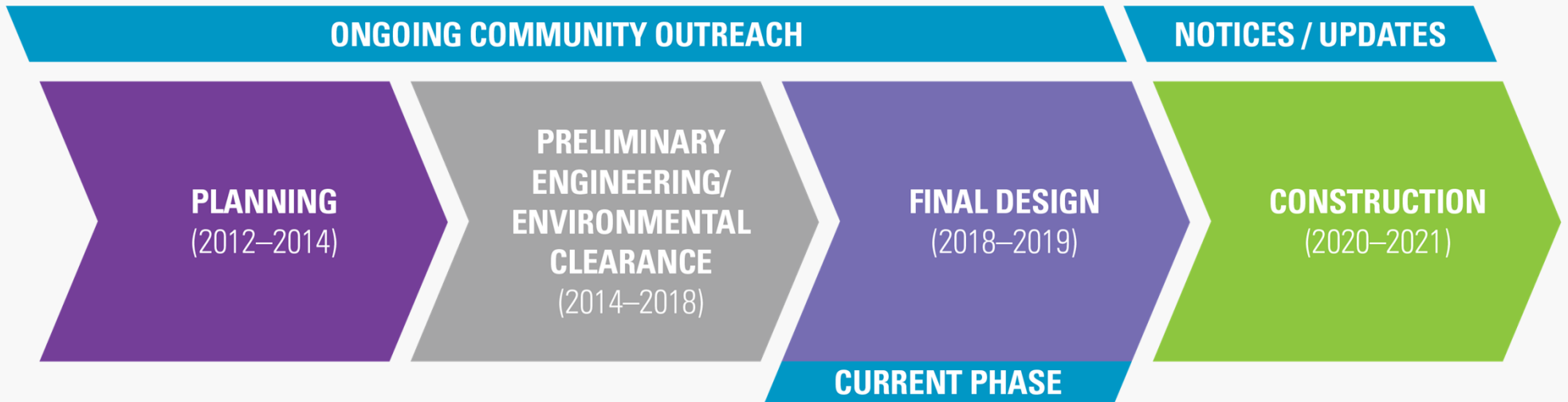
HOWARD BIKEWAY PROJECT UPDATE

- Environmentally cleared under CEQA on February 16, 2018
- Final Design recently began – extends through 2019
- Survey work (late fall/early winter 2018)
- Send complete plans to City of SD Development Services Department for review (2019)
- Landscape approach based on Green Streets Exemption and City of SD Comments
- Opportunity for future landscape enhancements – irrigation sleeves

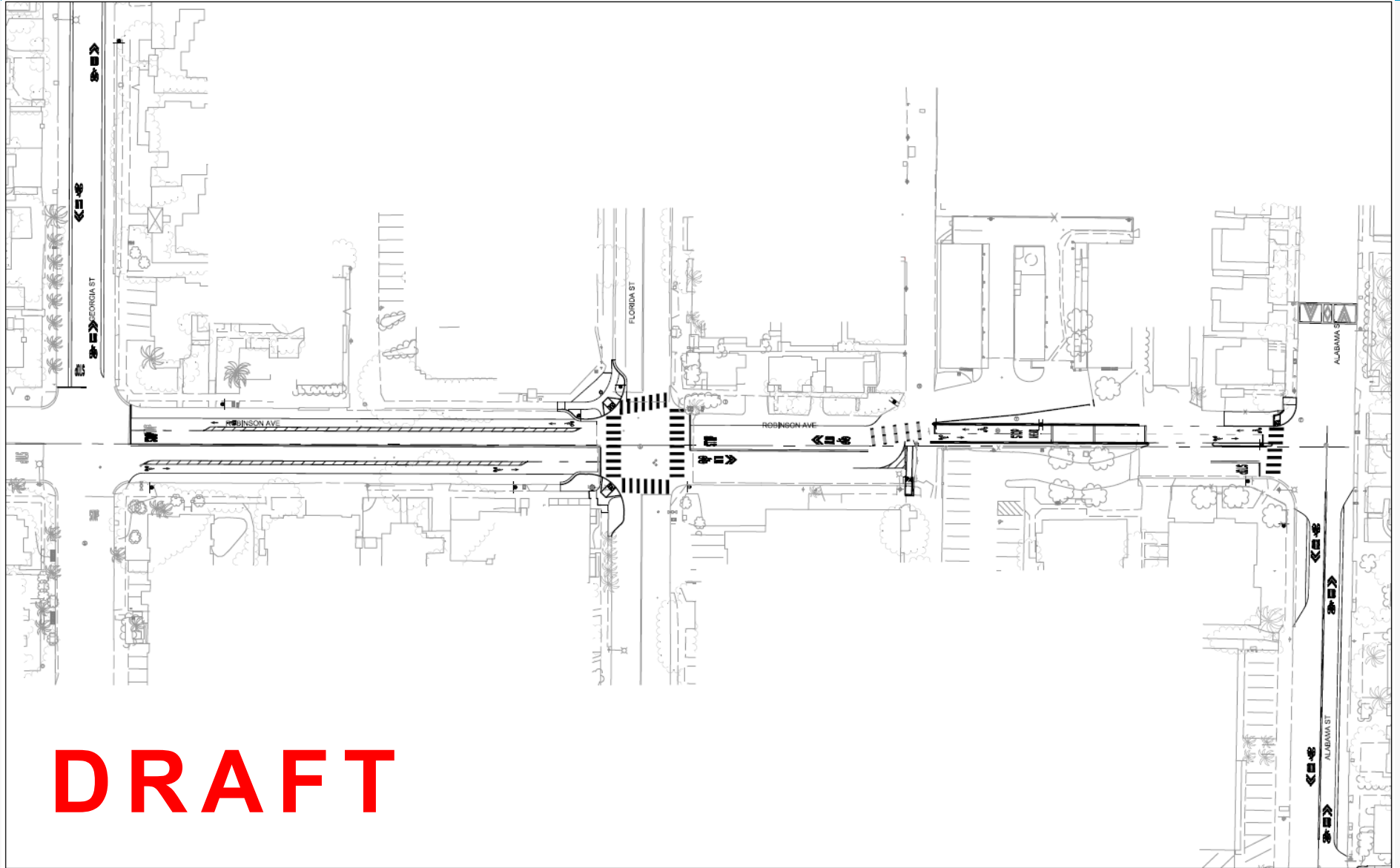

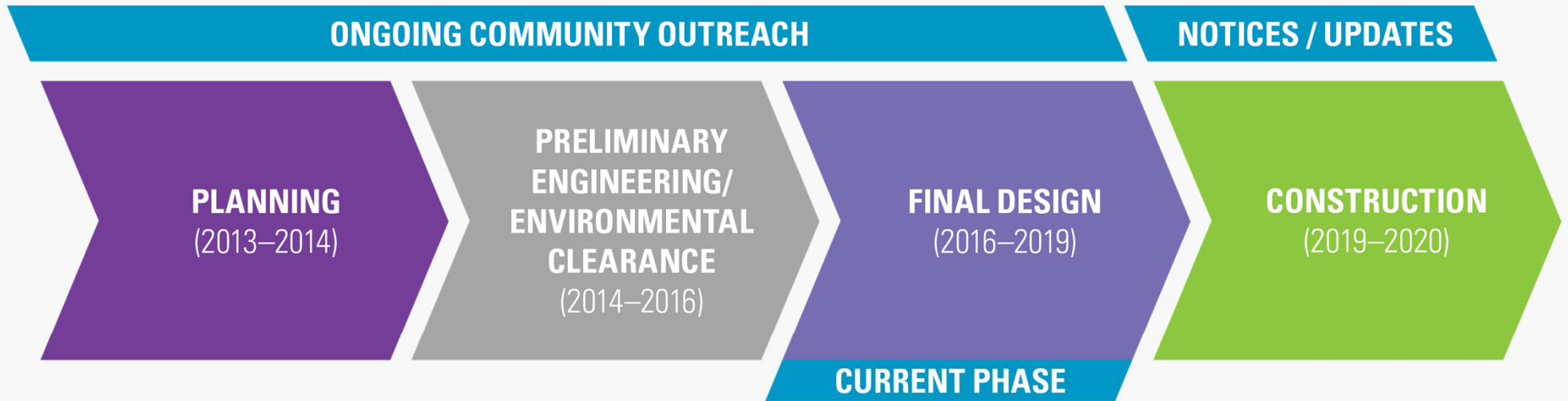
ROBINSON BIKEWAY PROJECT UPDATE

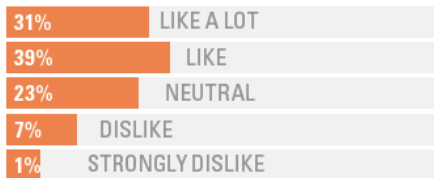

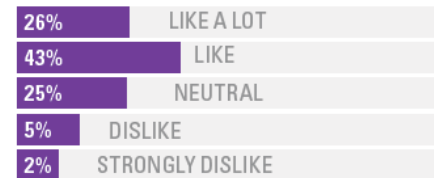

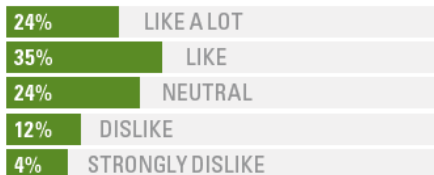

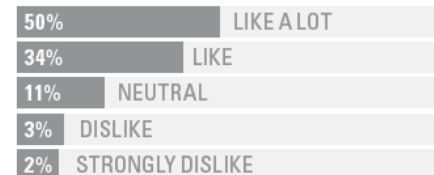

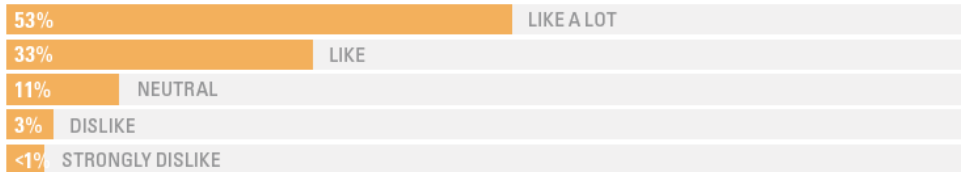
