The November 13 open house and public hearing marks an important step for the Border to Bayshore Bikeway project. SANDAG, as the lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), will hold a public hearing to hear comments on the proposed project. During the open house portion of the meeting, attendees will have the opportunity to talk with project team members and provide feedback. **Spanish translation and interpretation will be provided.** The SANDAG Transportation Committee is anticipated to consider whether the proposed project is exempt from CEQA at its December 14, 2018, meeting. Comments collected at the public hearing and open house and written responses to those comments will be provided to the Transportation Committee for its consideration before their December 14, 2018, meeting.
