

Update: Overnight Lane and Ramp Closures Continue on State Route 15 for Feb. 22 - March 3

Motorists Will Be Detoured

Lane and ramp closures will be in place along State Route 15 (SR 15) from Monday, Feb. 22 to Thursday, March 3.

The southbound on-ramp at Adams Avenue, the southbound off-ramp at El Cajon Boulevard, and up to two southbound lanes on SR 15 will be closed on Feb. 22 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

All southbound lanes on SR 15 between Interstate 8 (I-8) and El Cajon Boulevard will be closed on Feb. 29 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. During this time, the southbound off-ramps at Adams Avenue, El Cajon Boulevard, and University Avenue, and the southbound on-ramps at Adams Avenue and El Cajon Boulevard will be closed.

Motorists traveling south on SR 15 will be detoured to I-8, then southbound Interstate 805 (I-805), and then to southbound SR 15.

All northbound lanes on SR 15 between I-8 and I-805 will be closed on the nights of Feb. 23 – 25 and March 1 – March 3 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. During these times, the northbound on-ramps at University Avenue, El Cajon Boulevard, and Adams Avenue and the northbound on-ramp from I-805 to SR 15 will be closed.

Detour signs will be posted directing motorists traveling north on SR 15 to exit at I-805 north, then exit onto State Route 163 north, and then to northbound Interstate 15.

Ramp closures at Adams Avenue, El Cajon Boulevard, and University Avenue may begin as early as 7 p.m.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The \$65 million project will build San Diego's first freeway-level Rapid transit stations along SR 15 at El Cajon Boulevard and University Avenue. New 2.5-mile transit-only lanes also will be constructed within the existing SR 15 median from just north of Interstate 805 to just south of Interstate 8. The SR 15 Mid-City Centerline *Rapid* Transit Stations Project is expected to be completed in 2017.
