

Interstate 805 HOV/Carroll Canyon Road Extension Project Newsletter

Highway and Rail Projects to Improve Transportation Network in Sorrento Valley

In an effort to provide you with an update on the Interstate 805 HOV/Carroll Canyon Road Extension Project, we are writing to share with you the second in a series of newsletters that outline the progress we've made so far and to inform you about what's upcoming. The newsletter includes a construction progress report, a sneak peak at the next steps and information about the planned transportation and transit improvements for the Golden Triangle.

Scheduled to open to traffic in the summer of 2013, the Interstate 805 HOV/

Carroll Canyon Road Extension Project adds approximately two miles of new High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV), or carpool lanes, in each direction along I-805 from Interstate 5 to Carroll Canyon Road, offering new transportation choices for travelers. The project will also extend Carroll Canyon Road to connect with Sorrento Valley Road and surrounding businesses and adds a new northbound Direct Access Ramp (DAR).

Additionally, active construction is beginning early this month on Phase 1 of the Sorrento to Miramar Double

Track Project. The project is the first of two phases of construction that will help speed passenger and freight rail services by straightening the slowest, steepest, and highest curve territories of any segment on the Los Angeles-San Diego-San Luis Obispo (LOSSAN) rail corridor. Phase 1 of Sorrento to Miramar Double Track will provide 1.1 miles of second track, parallel to the existing track south of Sorrento Valley Boulevard to east of I-805 in the Golden Triangle. Phase 1 is expected to be completed by the end of 2013.
