SCHEDULE UPDATE

Rail bridge replacement work will continue through May 2014

Construction crews began work in April to replace a rail bridge, located just north of the Sorrento Valley COASTER Station. This work includes pile driving, which will have temporary and intermittent noise impacts. The construction crews will minimize noise as much as possible. To expedite construction, some work activities may be scheduled at night or on weekends. We appreciate your patience during construction.



Pile Driving Work Schedule:

May 2014 Monday through Friday 7 a.m. - 4 p.m.

Occasional night work (4 p.m. to 1:30 a.m.) and weekend work (day or night) may be necessary.

Please use extra caution near construction crews or vehicles.

<u>About the Project:</u> The Sorrento Valley Double Track Project will help to improve the reliability and on-time performance of COASTER, Amtrak, and BNSF Railway services. The project adds a second mainline track and a new 81-space surface parking lot. It also will replace two aging bridges, raise railroad tracks above the flooding level of 50-year storm events, and install drainage and embankment improvements.
