## OPEN HOUSE ON NOV. 8

Please join the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) for a community open house on Nov. 8 to learn more about the Interstate 805 (I-805) North Project.

This project is the first of five stages of construction. Stage 1 will build one carpool lane in each direction of I-805 from SR 52 to just north of Mira Mesa Boulevard. The first project will also build south facing Direct Access Ramps (DAR) at Carroll Canyon Road. Additional improvements will include bridge widening and noise barrier modifications.

Together, we are working to bring improvements to the I-805 North corridor and provide more transportation choices for the region. The I-805 North Project covers a distance of approximately four miles, from just south of State Route 52 (SR 52) to just north of Mira Mesa Boulevard in San Diego. The five-stage project will widen the freeway to accommodate four carpool, or High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV), lanes from SR 52 to La Jolla Village Drive and two carpool lanes from La Jolla Village Drive to just north of Mira Mesa Boulevard. The project also will construct DARs at Nobel Drive and Carroll Canyon Road, the Nobel Drive Park & Ride and Transit Station, a direct freeway-to-freeway HOV connector from westbound SR 52 to northbound I-805 and southbound I-805 to eastbound SR 52, and will reconfigure the Governor Drive interchange.
